Maaku mai! they shout, holding up their rusty sickles. There is no water!



Droughts are not rare in Iraq, though officials say they have been more frequent in recent years. But drought is only part of what is choking the Euphrates



and its larger, healthier twin, the Tigris.

The most frequently cited culprits are the Turkish and Syrian governments. Iraq has plenty of water, but it is a downstream country. There are at least seven dams on the Euphrates in Turkey and Syria, according to Iraqi water officials, and with no treaties or agreements, the Iraqi government is reduced to begging its neighbors for water.

At a conference in Baghdad where participants drank bottled water from Saudi Arabia, a country with a fraction of Iraqs fresh water officials spoke of disaster.

We have a real thirst in Iraq, said Ali Baban, the minister of planning. Our agriculture is going to die, our cities are going to wilt, and no state can keep quiet in such a situation.

...bitterness over Irags water threatens to be a source of tension for months or even years to come between Iraq and its neighbors.

Along the river, there is no shortage of resentment at the Turks and Syrians. But there is also resentment at the Americans, Kurds, Iranians and the Iraqi government, all of whom are blamed. Scarcity makes foes of everyone. nytimes.com

Destruction Prophesied For This Time Period


Yahweh shows that if mankind practices sin, which is the breaking of Yahweh's Perfect Laws Righteousness, he will bring what the Inspired Scriptures calls curses (sickness and disease) upon himself. Yahweh shows that when sin is practiced on a worldwide scale, defilement is brought upon the whole earth—the people, land, water and air. This defilement brings confusion to the mind of man, which results in uncontrolled lustful desires and actions that, in turn, lead to even more confusion.

When Yahweh brought the children of Israyl out of Egypt, He gave them

His Laws and showed them, and us, the results of keeping and the results of breaking those Laws. Notice His Words to you and all who will hear:

● Deuteronomy 28:1-14—

1 And it will be, if you will listen diligently to the Voice of Yahweh your Father, by observing and doing all His Laws which I command you this day, that Yahweh your Father will set you high above all the



nations on earth as His kings and priests.

2 And <u>all these blessings will come</u> <u>upon you</u>, and accompany you, because you obey Yahweh your Father:

3 Blessed will you be in the city, and blessed will you be in the country.

- 4 Blessed will be the fruit of your body, the produce of your ground, and the young of your livestock: the calves of your herds and the lambs of your flocks.
- 5 Blessed will be your basket and your storehouse.
- 6 Blessed will you be when you come in, and blessed will you be when you go out.
- 7 It will come to pass that your enemies, who rise up against you, will be caused to be defeated in front of you; they will come out against you from one direction, but flee from you in seven directions.
- 8 Yahweh will send a blessing on your barns and storehouses, and in everything you set your hand to do. Yahweh will bless you in the land which Yahweh your Father is giving you.
- 9 Yahweh will establish you as His Holy People unto Himself, as He promised you on oath, if you will keep the Laws of Yahweh your Father, and walk in all His Ways.

- 10 Then all the people on the earth will see that you are called by the Name of Yahweh, and they will fear you.
- 11 Yahweh will grant you plenteous possessions—in the fruit of your body, in the increase of your livestock, and in the produce of your ground—in the land Yahweh vowed on oath to your forefathers to give you.

12 Yahweh will open the heavens, the storehouse of His bountiful treasure, to send

rain upon your land in its season, and to bless all the work of your hands. You will lend to many nations, but you will borrow from none.

- 13 Yahweh will make you the head, and not the tail. You will be at the top only, and never be at the bottom, if you will pay attention to the Laws of Yahweh your Father, which I command you this day, and are *then* careful to observe and do them.
- 14 For if you diligently observe and do all of Yahweh's Law, then you will not turn aside from any of the Laws which I command you this day, to the right hand nor to the left; by going after any God (el) to serve it.

This was a warning and a prophecy. Notice the rest of the prophecy.

Deuteronomy 28:15-24—

- 15 However, if you do not obey Yahweh your Father, and <u>do not carefully follow all His Laws and His Statutes</u>, which I command you this day, then <u>all these curses will come upon you</u>, and accompany you:
- 16 Cursed will you be in the city, and cursed will you be in the country.
- 17 Cursed will be your basket and your storehouse.
- 18 Cursed will be the fruit of your body, the produce of your land, the calves of your herds, and the lambs of your flocks.
- 19 Cursed will you be when you come in, and cursed will you be when you go out.
- 20 Because of the wickedness you have done in forsaking Me, it will come to pass that you will have given yourselves over to curses, confusion, and rebuke, in everything you put your hand to do, until you are destroyed and come to sudden ruin,
- 21 It will come to pass that you will cause the plagues to cling to you, until you are destroyed from the land you are entering to possess.
- 22 It will come to pass that you will cause yourselves to be struck with consumption, with a fever, with an inflammation, with scorching heat, with the sword, with blasting, and with mildew; they will stay with you, until you perish.
- 23 And the heaven that is over your heads shall be brass, and the earth under you shall be iron.
- 24 It will come to pass that you will cause the rain of your land *to become* powder and dust: from heaven it shall come down upon you, until you are destroyed.

The Hebrew words for powder and dust, spoken of in verse 24, actually show the color and texture of the fallout dust from the present day nuclear bombs. The Scriptures show that Yahweh sets this scenario before mankind and says to choose the way of life you desire for yourself—a life of blessings or one filled with curses.

• Deuteronomy 30:15-20—

- 15 See, I have set before you this day life by Righteousness, and death by destruction—
- 16 In that I command you this day to love Yahweh your Father, by walking in *all* His Ways, by keeping His Laws, His Statutes, and His Judgments, so that you may live and multiply, and so Yahweh your Father may bless you in the land which you go in to possess.
- 17 But if your heart turns away, and you are not obedient, and you are drawn away to submit to Gods (elohim), to worship them by serving them—
- 18 I declare to you this day that you will surely perish; you will not prolong your days in the land which you cross over the Yardan to possess.
- 19 I call heaven and earth as witnesses against you this day, *that I* have set before you life and death, blessings and curses. *Because you are free agents to make your own choice between Righteousness and evil*—therefore choose life, so both you and your children may live;
- 20 So you may love Yahweh your Father, by listening to Him, and *then* obeying Him. Hold fast to Him, for He is your life. He will *also* give you many years in the land He vowed to give to your fathers; to Abraham, Isaac, and Yaaqob.

Many of the leaders of the twelve tribes of Israyl openly rebelled against Yahweh. They didn't desire the quiet, peaceful life that Yahweh's Laws bring when they are followed. We see the beginning of this rebellion of the kings of the east who wanted power over others and empires to rule. They didn't want to practice Righteousness.

• I Samuyl 8:1-9, 17-22—

- 1 When Samuyl became old, he made his sons judges over Israyl.
- 2 The name of his firstborn was Yahyl; *Yahweh is Strength*, and the name of his second was Abiyah; *My Father is Yahweh*. They judged in Beersheba;
- 3 But his sons did not walk in his ways. They sought dishonest gain, took bribes, and perverted justice.
- 4 Then <u>all the elders of Israyl gathered</u> together and approached Samuyl when he was at Ramah.
- 5 Saying to him; You are old, and your sons do not walk in your ways. Appoint us a king to judge us; just like all the *other* nations.
- 6 But these things displeased Samuyl, especially when they said; Give us a king

- to judge us. Then Samuyl prayed to Yahweh.
- 7 Yahweh answered Samuyl, and said: Listen to all the words the people speak to you, for they have not rejected you; they have rejected Me, that I should not reign over them.
- 8 Just as they have done to Me from the day I brought them out of Egypt, to this very day, they are now doing to you—they are forsaking Me in order to serve God(s); *Elohim!*
- 9 So, listen to them. However, solemnly forewarn them and let them know how the king who will reign over them will behave toward them.
- 17 He will demand a tenth of your sheep, and you, yourselves, will become his servants.
- 18 You will cry out in that day because of the king you wanted for yourselves, but in that day Yahweh will not listen to you.
- 19 However, the people refused to listen to Samuyl's warning, and answered; No, we want a king *to reign* over us.
- 20 We want to be *just* like all the *other* nations. We want a king to judge us and lead us in our battles.
- 21 Samuyl listened to all the words of the people, then he repeated them in the hearing of Yahweh.
- 22 So Yahweh instructed Samuyl: Listen to their demands, and appoint them a king. Then Samuyl said to the men of Israyl; Every man return to his city.

Yahweh said that from Abraham's seed would come blessings to all nations. As you read the following please keep in mind that true blessings are peace, joy, true love, healthy bodies and minds, working together in harmony, loving others as yourself, and being a servant. The Savior set the Perfect Example of being a Servant and attained true blessings. The things just mentioned are true blessings, not building bombs and such like things.

The blessings promised to Abraham were offered by every Inspired Prophet during each Work of Yahweh in the past 6,000 years. This was all according to Yahweh's Plan as is shown in:

• Genesis 26:1-5—

- 1 There was a famine in the land, besides the first famine that was in the days of Abraham. And Isaac went to Abimelech king of the Philistines in Gerar.
- 2 Then Yahweh appeared to him, and said: Do not go down to Egypt;
- 3 Stay in this land, and I will be with you and bless you; for to you and your seed I give all these lands, and I will confirm the oath I vowed to Abraham your father.
- 4 And I will make your seed multiply as the stars of heaven; I will give to your seed all these lands; and in <u>your seed</u> all the nations of the earth shall be blessed;
- 5 Because <u>Abraham obeyed</u> My Voice, and kept My Charge, My <u>Commandments</u>, My <u>Statutes</u>, and My <u>Laws</u>.

• Amosyah 3:1-2—

1 Hear this word which Yahweh has spoken against you, O children of Israyl, against the whole family which I brought up from the land of Egypt, saying:

2 You only have I known of all the families of the earth; therefore, I will call you to account for all your iniquities.

Little to nothing is known about the rest of the Prophecy that is shown about this family—the lineage of Abraham. You are going to learn about Yahweh's Blessing and the work that was designed to stop Yahweh's Blessing. Notice the opposition from false prophets (teachers of religions).

Yeremyah 23:15—

Therefore, this is what Yahweh says concerning these prophets; Behold, they will be fed with wormwood, and they will be made to drink the water of gall; for from the prophets of Yerusalem <u>profaneness has</u> gone out into all the land.

This is speaking of the kings of the east, who openly rebelled against Yahweh in the days of the Great Prophet Samuyl, and their followers who spread throughout the whole world. The word profaneness in Yeremyah 23:15 comes from two Hebrew words and means: moral filth, wickedness, hypocrisy, pollute, defile, greatly corrupt, profane. The Great Prophet Yeremyah said that from this family these things went out into all the land. Compare:

• Yeremyah 23:1-2, 10-11, 14-15—

- 1 Woe to the <u>pastors</u>; *shepherds*, who <u>destroy and scatter the sheep</u> of My Pasture! says Yahweh.
- 2 Therefore, this is what Yahweh, the Father of Israyl, says against the pastors who feed My People: You have scattered My Flock, and <u>driven them away</u>, and have not visited; *attended to*, them. Behold, you are going to be called to account for the evil of your doings, says Yahweh:
- 10 For the land is full of adulterers; those who turn from following Yahweh to follow the gods (elohim). Because of this curse the land mourns; the pleasant places of the wilderness are dried up. Their conduct is evil, whose might is not right—
- 11 For both prophet and priest are profane! Yes, even in My own House I have found their wickedness! says Yahweh.
- 14 I have also seen in the prophets of Yerusalem a horrible thing—they commit adultery and walk in lies; they turn from Yahweh and follow after the gods (elohim)! They also strengthen the hands of evildoers, so that no one turns back from his wickedness. All of them are like Sodom to Me, and her inhabitants are like Gomorrah.
- 15 Therefore, this is what Yahweh says concerning these prophets; Behold, they will be fed with wormwood, and they will be made to drink the water of gall; for from

gone out into all the land.

The pastors in Yeremyah's day are the same as those in Samuyl's. They belong to the same religious system that openly rebelled against Yahweh before Samuyl.

• I Samuyl 8:4-5, 7—

- 4 Then all the elders of Israyl gathered together and approached Samuyl when he was at Ramah.
- 5 Saying to him; You are old, and your sons do not walk in your ways. Appoint us a king to judge us; just like all the other nations.
- 7 Yahweh answered Samuyl, and said: Listen to all the words the people speak to you, for they have not rejected you; they have <u>rejected Me</u>, that I should not reign over them.
- Strong's Exhaustive Concordance gives us the following information about the elders. #2205

(1) The word zagen has a specialized use as elder (1a) recognized by the people for his gifts of leadership, wisdom, and justice (1b) set apart to administer justice, settle disputes, and guide the people of his charge; (1c) known as officers (shotrim -7860), heads of the tribes, and judges (Josh 23:2); (1d) consulted by the king, but the king could determine his own course of action (1 Kin 12:8). (2) In a given city, the governing council was made up of the elders who (2a) were charged with the well-being of the town (1 Sa 16:4) and (2b) met in session by the city gate (Eze 8:1), with the place of meeting known as the seat/council/assembly of the elders (Ps

The Laws of Yahweh were created to guide people into total Righteousness and total peace. But this group from the lineage of Abraham rejected Yahweh and brought their rebellion, evil or profaneness to all the world.

From Strong's Exhaustive Concordance we see that the Hebrew word translated land in Yeremyah 23:15 has the following meaning:

776. ארץ (2504x) 'erets, eh'-rets; from an unused root prob. mean. to be firm; the earth (at large, or partitively a land): - land (1543x), earth (712x), country (140x), ground (98x), world (4x), way (3x), common (1x), field {1x}. nations (1x), wilderness + 4057 {1x}-

Erets (776) means "earth; land." (1) Erets may be translated "earth," the temporal scene of human activity, experience, and history (2) The material world had a beginning when God "made the earth by His power," "formed it," and "spread it out" (Is 40:28; 42:5; 45:12, 18; Jer 27:5;

These kings of the east, from the lineage of Abraham, rebelled against

the prophets of Yerusalem <u>profaneness has</u> Yahweh around 1112 B.C.E. The tribes grew, multiplied, moved to other areas and took over land outside of the tiny land of Israyl. They did not stick with the worship of Yahweh and His Laws. In fact, they went back to Egypt in their hearts and minds and spread the customs of Egypt throughout the nations they took over, which were many.

> In Israyl, they had opposition from Yahweh's Called Out Ones so there were wars among the tribes. Israyl and Yahdah fought against each other. There was no peace after King Solomon. There was only continual war.

> Not everyone from the twelve tribes rejected Yahweh as the Holy Prophets and Apostles tell us. From the lineage of Abraham a Righteous seed would come forth that will be given authority and bring Righteousness to all nations of the earth. Yahshua was the first to receive this Authority. He is the first of many brethren who will make up the Kingdom of Yahweh and receive Authority to finish Yahweh's Plan from the beginning.

• Romans 8:18-21—

- 18 For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which will be revealed in us.
- 19 For the earnest expectation of the creation waits for the revealing of the Sons of Yahweh.
- 20 For the creation was made subject to emptiness, not willingly, but by the will of Him Who subjected it in hope;
- 21 Because the creation itself will also be delivered from the bondage of corruption into this glorious liberty by the Children of Yahweh.

The Righteousness that Abraham lived is what makes the Sons of Yahweh in His Image, as it did Yahshua. Read again:

Genesis 26:4—

And I will make your seed multiply as the stars of heaven; I will give to your seed all these lands; and in your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed.

The Great Prophet Amosyah showed all the evil in the world but said that Yahweh would bring forth His Prophesied Work. Regardless of all the evil of Satan, Yahweh will complete His Plan through His Prophesied Work so no person will have the excuse that he did not know.

Luke 24:25—

Then He said to them: O fools, and slow

of heart to believe all that the Prophets have spoken!

Amosyah shows that Yahweh will have no work unless it was prophesied in advance by the Holy Prophets of old.

Amosyah 3:7—

Most assuredly Father Yahweh will have no work, other than the Work that He has <u>prophesied in advance</u> by His Servants the Prophets.

From this family of Abraham, who brought forth twelve tribes, came a multitude of nations. If you don't believe this, you will believe the guesswork printed in many books. Learn to believe all that the Prophets have spoken and you will begin to see Yahweh's Plan carried out, step-by-step. Prophecy by prophecy the Plan of Yahweh is being carried out.

■ Yahchanan 1:1-3—

- 1 In the beginning was the Plan of Yahweh, and the Plan was with Yahweh, and the Plan was Yahweh's.
- 2 The same Plan was in the beginning with Yahweh.
- 3 All things were done according to it, and without it nothing was done, that was

Remember, the Plan of Yahweh is shown in the beginning. That word **beginning** is translated from the Hebrew word bereshith (Genesis).

Luke 24:25-

Then He said to them: O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the Prophets have spoken!

Genesis 1:26-

Then Yahweh said: I will make man in My Image, according to My Likeness; they will have rulership over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, over the cattle,



and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth.

This is a Prophecy. No murderer has Eternal Life abiding in him.

● I Yahchanan 3:15-

Whoever hates his neighbor is a murderer; and you know that no murderer has Eternal Life abiding in him.

Therefore, murder is not part of the Image of Yahweh. The Image of Yahweh is Perfect Righteousness, which is found in His Laws.

● I Yahchanan 3:4, 7-8—

4 Whoever commits sin, transgresses also the Laws; for sin is the transgression of the Laws

7 Little children, let no man deceive you; he who practices Righteousness is Righteous, just as He is Righteous.

8 He who commits sin is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of Yahweh was manifested; that He might destroy the works of the devil.

The Spirit of Yahweh is shown in His

Yahchanan 6:63—

It is the Spirit that gives life; the flesh is useless. The Laws that I speak to you, they are Spirit, and they are life everlasting.

● Psalm 18:30-

As for Yahweh, His Way is Perfect; the Laws of Yahweh are tried. He is a Buckler to all those who trust in Him.

Psalm 19:7-

The Laws of Yahweh are Perfect, converting the whole person. The Testimony of Yahweh is sure, making the simple ones

The reason stated for choosing Abraham is because he kept; that is, lived by and practiced the same Laws that Yahweh, our Heavenly Father, lives by. His way is perfect. The Savior says to all people, not just those of His time period, to become perfect.

Mattithyah 5:48—

Therefore, become perfect, just as your Father Who is in heaven is Perfect.

Luke 6:40-

The disciple is not above his teacher, but everyone who is perfect will be as his Teacher.

• II Timothy 3:12—

Yes, and all who will live Righteously, as Yahshua Messiah, will suffer persecution.

Remember, from Abraham's seed came Yahshua, the prophesied Savior. Believe the Inspired Prophets whom Yahweh inspired to write Yahweh's Plan for us. I'm including a beautiful part of this Plan in this letter.

Understand Why The True Savior, Yahshua, Was Persecuted, Arrested, And Murdered

The Savior and His Disciples were all born and raised in Galilee, in the area of the original House of Yahweh that Yahweh started with the Prophet and Priest Abel. A city remains there today and is very much a part of the Prophecies for Yahweh's Planned Last Days' Work.

Abel was murdered for the same reason that Yahshua was murdered, for teaching Yahweh's Laws and exposing sin in the Yerusalem temple era. Notice why Cain killed Abel.

• Genesis 4:1-8-

- 1 Now Adam knew Eve his wife, and she conceived and bore Cain, and she said; I have brought forth a man with the help of Yahweh.
- 2 Then she bore again; this time his brother Abel was born. Now Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground.
- 3 And on one of Yahweh's Sabbaths, it came to pass that Cain brought an offering of the fruit of the ground to Yahweh;
- 4 And Abel, besides bringing his offering of the fruit of the ground, also brought a sacrifice of the firstlings of his flock and of their fat. And Yahweh honored Abel and his offerings;
- 5 But He did not honor Cain and his offering. And Cain was very angry, and his countenance fell.

6 So Yahweh said to Cain: Why are you angry? Why are you downcast?

7 If you do Righteousness, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do Righteousness, sin is crouching at your door. The desire to sin is with you, but you must overcome it!

8 Now Cain talked with Abel his brother; and it came to pass, when they were spread abroad, that Cain rose against Abel his brother and killed him.

• Genesis 3:15-

And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel.

Romans 8:6—

For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

Compare:

• Romans 7:12, 14—

12 Therefore the Law is Holy, and the Commandments are Holy, and just, and Righteous.

14 For we know that the Laws are spiritual; but I was carnal, sold into the power of sin.

Mattithyah 5:28—

woman with lust for her, has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

Please notice, to study and practice Yahweh's Laws is to be spiritually minded. To lust after and practice sin, the breaking of Yahweh's Laws, is to be carnally minded. Yahshua shows in Mattithyah 5:29-30 that unless you repent and overcome, you will burn in Gehenna (hell).

Mattithyah 5:29-30—

29 So if your right eye causes you to offend; sin, gouge it out and throw it from you! For it is better for you that one of your members perish, than for the whole body to be cast into Gehenna.

30 Or if your right hand causes you to offend, cut it off and throw it from you! For it is better for you that one of your members perish, than for the whole body to be cast into Gehenna.

Romans 8:7–

Because the carnal mind is enmity against; bitterly opposed to, Yahweh; for it is not subject to the Laws of Yahweh, nor indeed can be.

Practicing Yahweh's Laws converts the mind and heart. Compare:

Romans 6:16-

Do you not know that to whom you yield yourselves as servants to obey, his servants you are whom you obey—whether of sin, which leads to death, or of obedience, which leads to Righteousness?

I Yahchanan 3:4-

Whoever commits sin, transgresses also the Laws; for sin is the transgression of the Laws.

I Yahchanan 2:4—

He who says: I know Him, but does not keep His Laws, is a liar, and the Truth is not in him.

■ I Yahchanan 3:7-8—

7 Little children, let no man deceive you; he who practices Righteousness is Righteous, just as He is Righteous.

8 He who commits sin is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of Yahweh was manifested; that He might destroy the works of the devil.

I Yahchanan 3:10-12—

10 In this the Children of Yahweh and the children of the devil are manifest. Whoever does not practice Righteousness is not of Yahweh, and he does not love his neighbor!

11 For this is the Message that you heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.

12 Not as Cain, who was of that wicked one, and murdered his brother. And why did he murder his brother? Because his works were evil, and his brother's were Righteous.

Yahchanan (John) came preaching But I say to you: Whoever looks on a Yahweh's Laws. The children of the against Yahweh (I Samuyl 8), now had control of the temple and Yerusalem. They arrested Yahchanan and put him to death because he exposed their sins.

• Yahchanan Mark 6:17-18—

17 Because Herod himself had sent and arrested Yahchanan, and put him in prison for Herodias' sake, his brother Philip's wife, for he had married her.

18 For Yahchanan had said to Herod; It is not Lawful for you to have your brother's wife.

You shall not commit adultery is the Seventh Commandment of the Ten Commandments.

• Exodus 20:3-17-

- 3 You shall have no hinder Gods (elohim) at all. They are in opposition against Me.
- 4 You shall not make for yourself any carved image; an idol, in the form of anything in heaven above, or on the earth beneath, or in the waters below.
- 5 You shall not bow down to them nor serve them; for I, Yahweh your Father, am a Heavenly Father Who is zealous for My House. I will make it known that the diseases caused by the sexual misconduct of the fathers will be upon their children to the third and fourth generation of those who hate Me,
- 6 But I will show My Love to thousands who love Me by keeping My Laws.
- 7 You shall not take the Name of Yahweh your Heavenly Father to bring it to nothing, for Yahweh will not hold him guiltless who brings dishonor upon or profanes His Name.
- 8 Remember the Sabbath Day, to keep
- 9 Six days you shall labor and do all vour work.

However, few will be given Eternal Life in this time period because of the deception that comes from all religions. Yahweh says they will not repent.

• Revelation 9:20-21-

20 And the rest of the men who were not killed by these plagues, still did not repent of the works of their hands, that they should not worship demons, and Gods (elohim, teraphim) of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which can neither see, nor hear, nor walk;

21 Neither did they repent of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts.

Mattithyah 19:17–

But He said to him: Why do you question Me about Righteousness? There is only One Who is the Standard of Perfection, and He is Yahweh; so if you would enter into life, keep the Laws of Yahweh.

Mattithyah 7:13-14-

13 Enter in through the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and many are those who go that way.

14 Because straight is the gate, and narrow is the way which leads to life, and few there are who find it.

Mattithyah 7:21-23-

- 21 Not everyone who says to Me; Teacher! Teacher! will enter into the Kingdom of Yahweh, but only he who does the will of My Father Who is in heaven.
- 22 Many will say to Me in that day; Teacher! Teacher! Have we not prophesied in Your Name, and cast out demons in Your Name, and in Your Name performed many wonderful works?
- 23 But then I will declare to them; I never knew you. Get away from Me, you who practice iniquity.

According to the Greek dictionary in Strong's Exhaustive Concordance, the word **iniquity** is word #458 from word #459, and means: not subject to the Laws.

458. avoula anomia, an-om-ee'-ah; from 459; illegality, i.e. violation of law or (gen.) wickedness: iniquity, x transgress (-ion of) the law, unrighteous-

459. avouos anomos, an'-om-os; from I (as a neg. particle) and 3551; lawless, i.e. (neg.) not subject to (the Jewish) law; (by impl. a Gentile), or (pos.) wicked:-without law, lawless, transgressor, unlawful, wicked.

Yahchanan 15:22-23—

22 If I had not come and spoken to them, they would not have had their sins revealed; but now they have no cloak, covering for, their sins.

23 He who hates Me, also hates My Father.

Salvation because of the persecution that follows.

The kings of the east, who rebelled against Yahweh, were violent men. They still are. They crusade against any form of Holiness, putting fear into those who would openly follow Yahweh's Laws. They brought profaneness on all the world because they had already changed Yahweh's Laws. They accused anyone who used Yahweh's Name of blasphemy, which held a penalty of death. This was in hopes of turning everyone away from Yahweh's Prophets and His House to their rebellious religion of Babylon (Rome).

Yeremyah 11:21—

Therefore this is what Yahweh says concerning the men of Anathoth who seek your life, saying; Do not prophesy in the Name of Yahweh, or you will die by our hand!

Yeremyah 23:26-27—

26 How long will this be in the heart of the prophets who prophesy lies? Yes, they are prophets of the deceit of their own

27 Who devise; plan and scheme, to cause My People to forget My Name through their dreams, which they tell every man to his neighbor, just as their fathers have forgotten My Name for Baal; Lord.

Yeremyah 23:21-22-

21 I have not sent these prophets, yet they ran; I have not spoken of them, yet they prophesied.

22 But if they had stood in My Counsel, and had caused My People to hear My Words; the Laws and the Prophets, then they would have turned them from their evil way, and from the evil of their doings.

Evil is not of the Spirit of Yahweh or Yahshua. Those who practice evil are not taking on the Image of Yahweh.

In seeking to kill Yahshua, the Pharisees accused Him of blasphemy, because Yahshua, like the Holy Prophets and the Apostles, used Yahweh's Name and taught others to do the same.

In the time of Yeremyah, the kings of the east were in power. They were the prophets of the Lord (Yeremyah 23:26-27). They did not stand in Yahweh's Counsel; that is, they did not teach Yahweh's Laws, nor did they teach by Yahweh's Authority.

Yeremyah 23:21-22—

21 I have not sent these prophets, yet they ran; I have not spoken of them, yet they prophesied.

22 But if they had stood in My Counsel, and had caused My People to hear My Words; the Laws and the Prophets, then they would have turned them from their evil way, and from the evil of their doings.

They were the pastors or priests, the leaders of the twelve tribes that took control of the temple by force. They were deeply involved in sin and lead the people into sin also.

Yeremvah 23:10-11-

10 For the land is full of adulterers; those who turn from following Yahweh to follow the Gods (elohim). Because of this curse the land mourns; the pleasant places of the wilderness are dried up. Their conduct is evil, whose might is not right-

11 For both prophet and priest are profane! Yes, even in My own House I have found their wickedness! says Yahweh.

Pharisees And Sadducees

These violent men were in positions of leadership. They forced their way, which was the way of Satan, upon the people of Israyl in Yeremyah's generation, and even before. The Savior spoke of these men and how they forcefully took the Kingdom of Yahweh that was set up by Mosheh.

● Matthew 11:12, KJV—

And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.

The *Diaglott* shows that the words translated and from are correctly translated from. The New Strong's Exhaustive Concordance shows these words mean after this manner. Matthew 11:12 correctly reads: From and after this manner in days of Yahchanan also the Kingdom of Yahweh suffers violence and violent men take it by force.

The subject of this lesson starts with the violent persecution of The House of Yahweh for teaching Yahweh's Laws. This is shown in:

Mattithvah 10:25-28-

25 It is enough for the disciple that he becomes like his teacher, and the servant like his ruler. If they have called the Head of the house: Baalzebul; *Lord the Prince*, how much more will they misrepresent those of His household?

26 But do not fear them, for there is nothing covered, that will not be revealed; or hidden, that will not be known.

27 What I tell you in the dark, speak out in the daylight; and what you hear in the ear, preach upon the housetops.

28 And do not fear those who kill the body, but are not able to kill the spirit; but rather, fear Him Who is able to destroy both spirit and body in Gehenna.

Notice, these murderers were priests that forcefully controlled the temple. The Savior is saying in **Mattithyah** 11:12, "Thus, the violent persecute thus and in the time Yahchanan." Yes, violent, unrighteous, murderous men persecuted all the Prophets who spoke from the days of Noah until and thus with Yahchanan also.

Stephen spoke of this corrupt religious system.

• Acts 7:51-53-

51 You stiffnecked; stubborn, and uncircumcised in heart and ears! You do always resist Spirit Holy! Just as your fathers did, so you do also!

52 Which of the Prophets have not your fathers persecuted? And they have slain those who foretold the coming of the Just One; of Whom you now have become the betrayers and murderers-

53 You, who have received the Laws as they were ordained and delivered by malakim, have not kept them!

The arrest and imprisonment are shown in:

• Acts 4:1-4—

1 And as they spoke to the people, the priests, the captains of The House of Yahweh, and the Sadducees came upon

2 Being indignant that they taught the people, and preached the resurrection from the dead through Yahshua.

3 So they laid hands on them, and placed them under arrest until the next day; for it was already evening.

4 However, many of those who heard the Word; the Laws and the Prophets, believed; and the number of the men was about five thousand.

Notice in **verse 4** that many believed.

• Acts 6:7—

And the Word of Yahweh increased, and the number of the Disciples greatly multiplied in Yerusalem, and a great many of the Priests were obedient to the Faith.

Now notice what they were teaching.

• Acts 3:19-

Repent therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out; that times of refreshing may come from the Presence of

Yes, many were not fooled by men who said that the Laws of Yahweh were done away with and to only follow their traditions.

Remember the word **elders** in:

● I Samuvl 8:1-5-

1 When Samuyl became old, he made his sons judges over Israyl.

2 The name of his firstborn was Yahyl;

Yahweh is Strength, and the name of his second was Abiyah; My Father is Yahweh. They judged in Beersheba;

3 But his sons did not walk in his ways. They sought dishonest gain, took bribes, and perverted justice.

4 Then all the elders of Israyl gathered together and approached Samuyl when he was at Ramah,

5 Saying to him; You are old, and your sons do not walk in your ways. Appoint us a king to judge us; just like all the other nations.

Compare:

Mattithyah 15:1-3—

1 Then scribes and Pharisees from Yerusalem came to Yahshua, and said;

2 Why do Your Disciples transgress the traditions of the elders? For they do not wash their hands when they eat.

3 But He answered, and said to them: And why do you transgress the Laws of Yahweh by your traditions?

These are the children of their fathers who killed the Prophets.

Mattithyah 23:28-31—

28 In the same way, you appear outwardly Righteous to men, but inside you are full of hypocrisy and the breaking of Yahweh's Laws.

29 Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! You build the tombs of the Prophets, and decorate the sepulchers of the Righteous,

30 And say; If we had been living in the days of our fathers, we would have had no part with them in the killing of the prophets.

31 In saying that, you witness against yourselves that you are the children of those who murdered the Prophets.

This is speaking of the same evil religious system that later moved the artifacts of the temple to Rome when Titus burned the temple. Remember the words of the Savior's Prophecy:

Mattithvah 24:1-2—

1 Yahshua went out and was leaving the temple, when His Disciples came to show *Him* the buildings of the temple.

2 But Yahshua said to them: Do you see all these things? Truly I say to you: There will not be one stone left sitting on top of another, which will not be thrown down.

The Twelve Tribes Were Not Just In The Land Of **Israyl At That Time**

Prophecy shows that the twelve tribes became a multitude.

• Genesis 48:4, 16, 19—

- 4 Saying: I will make you fruitful and multiply you, and I will make of you a multitude of people, and give this land to your descendants after you *for* an everlasting possession.
- 16 May my name be called upon them, and the name of my fathers, Abraham and Isaac. May they increase greatly in the midst of the earth.
- 19 But his father refused, and said; I know, my son, I know. He, too, will become a people, and he too will become great; nevertheless, his younger brother will be greater than he, and his descendants will become a multitude of nations.

This Prophecy was given around 1689 B.C.E. The Acts of the Apostles were written around 29-33 C.E. That's about 1722 years after the Prophecy written in Genesis 48. They had indeed become a multitude of nations. In fact, they had taken many of the nations by the time of Daniyl the Prophet, and were still multiplying in 607 B.C.E. That was 1082 years after the Prophecy of Genesis 48 was written.

Remember, Amosyah said:

Amosyah 3:1-2—

- 1 Hear this word which Yahweh has spoken against you, O children of Israyl, against the whole family which I brought up from the land of Egypt, saying:
- 2 You only have I known of all the families of the earth; therefore, I will call you to account for all your iniquities.

Amosyah wrote around 787 B.C.E., which was about 180 years before the Prophet Daniyl.

Daniyl was inspired to write that the army would stand on the part of the religion—priests, elders, leaders that changed Yahweh's Laws and fights against the Saints.

Notice in **Amosyah 3:2** and keep in mind that of all the families of the earth, Yahweh has only dealt with the one family of the seed of Abraham in bringing forth His Plan. Salvation is offered to others besides Abraham's lineage, but they must come to the Prophesied Place Yahweh chooses.

Now notice, the army will stand on the part of this un-named rebellious religion, which is called <u>little</u> in **Daniyl**. **Little** means *worthless*; worthless as far as Salvation is concerned.

• Daniyl 11:31—

And the army will stand on his part, and they will pollute the sanctuary of strength, and will take away the daily *sacrifice*, and they will place the Lord of heaven.

Also notice that this army along with the Levitical priesthood (Isayah 43:27-28), made up of elders (I Samuyl 8:1) from the twelve tribes, the family of Abraham, would pollute the sanctuary.

• Daniyl 11:31-32—

- 31 And the army will stand on his part, and they will pollute the sanctuary of strength, and will take away the daily *sacrifice*, and they will place the Lord of heaven.
- 32 And such as do wickedly against the Covenant will he corrupt; *make apostatize*, by flatteries. But the people who do know their Father will be strong, and do; *firmly resist*.

The Army—What Army?

Daniyl saw a fourth kingdom, which came out of the only family of all the families of the earth that Yahweh is dealing with, the family of Abraham, that would rule the earth for a short time. Daniyl was shown that the army would be used to destroy the temple and move many of the artifacts to Babylon. Babylon, at that time, was ruled by some of the rebellious, violent men of the twelve tribes who had multiplied and taken the land. As is shown by the Great Prophet Yeremyah, they followed the rebellious system called Nimrod that was fathered by Cush. For full details about this system get the recorded sermon series titled The Institution Named Nimrod That Brings Folly To The World Spoken Of By Yahshua In Luke 24:25. These are those who do not believe.

The nations of the twelve tribes had multiplied greatly and had taken over many nations and people. The kings over the people in different portions of the fourth part of the earth, called the Middle East, are thought to be from people other than the twelve tribes. This is all part of the guesswork of the bible scholars as you can see in their wording. They will say, "perhaps he was... or, he may have been of this or that descent". This simply means they don't know.

One thing you can trust are the words of the Prophets and the stern words of Yahshua Messiah that He spoke in:

• Luke 24:25—

Then He said to them: <u>O fools</u>, and <u>slow</u> of heart to believe all that the Prophets have spoken!

Groups of people from the twelve tribes split off and formed their own governments and chose their own kings. Some of these became kingdoms with strong armies. The kingdoms with the strongest armies forced the weaker kingdoms to pay tribute. If a king refused, then war began. This is what we see in the books of the kings of Israyl (I Kings and II Kings).

With that in mind, look at:

• Daniyl 1:1-2—

- 1 In the third year of the reign of Yahyakim king of Yahdah, Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came against Yerusalem, and besieged it;
- 2 And Yahweh handed Yahyakim king of Yahdah over to him, with some of the articles of The House of Yahweh, which he carried into the land of Shinar to the house of his God (el); placing the articles into the treasure house of his God (el).

Notice in verse 2, only part of the articles or vessels of The House of Yahweh were taken. Yahweh only allowed King Nebuchadnezzar to take part of the vessels from The House of Yahweh. Yahweh did not allow the civil or religious constitution of Yahdah to be stopped, nor is there any indication that King Nebuchadnezzar wanted to shut down the operation at that time.

King Nebuchadnezzar was a Hebrew. He was from one of the twelve tribes, the family of Abraham. There has never been any proof that shows otherwise. He was not a believer in Yahweh. In fact, he worshipped Baal, the Lord, as many of the twelve tribes did and were condemned by Yahweh's Prophets whom Yahweh sent to warn them of what God worship would bring upon them.

The thing that sets Baal worshippers apart from those of Yahweh is the fact that they pay honor to the Queen of Heaven and celebrate pagan holidays. Nebuchadnezzar was king over a large group of Hebrews from the twelve tribes who, with a large army, took over practically all of the main cities of Asia and the established Babylonian empire. This empire later became known as the "Holy" Roman empire when the people started submitting to the rabbis, as is prophesied in **Daniyl 7**.

Let's look at Daniyl 1:1-2 again.

Daniyl 1:1-2—

1 In the third year of the reign of Yahyakim king of Yahdah, Nebuchadnezzar

king of Babylon came against Yerusalem,

and besieged it;

2 And Yahweh handed Yahyakim king of Yahdah over to him, with some of the articles of The House of Yahweh, which he carried into the land of Shinar to the house of his God (el); placing the articles into the treasure house of his God (el).

The army took these vessels of The House of Yahweh to the land of Shinar. Shinar is the ancient name of Babylon as is shown in:

• Genesis 11:2—

And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east; the beginning, that they found a plain in the land of Shinar; Babylon, and they settled there.

Baal, the Lord, had a splendid temple in Babylon. There were also schools of Nimrod or higher learning where skills, psychology, literature and the language of the <u>Chaldeans</u> were taught. The Chaldeans, like Rome, are a mystery. One thing that is known about them is that they are mentioned in Babylonian inscriptions. The fact that they spoke Hebrew means that they were of the twelve tribes. They worshipped Baal or the Lord and the Queen of Heaven. They kept the same holidays that Christianity keeps today, which are condemned by the Prophets of Yahweh. Notice:

• Isayah 65:1-7-

1 I am sought by those who did not ask for Me; I am found by those who did not seek Me. I said: Here I am, here I am, to a nation that was not called with My Name.

2 I have spread out My Hands all the day to a rebellious people, who walk in a way which is not right, after their own thoughts; devices;

- 3 A people who act defiantly against Me continually to My Face; who sacrifice in gardens, and burn incense on altars of brick;
- 4 Who assemble and spend the night keeping memorials for the dead, who eat swine's flesh, and the broth of abominable things; unclean foods, is in their vessels,

5 Who say; Stand by yourself! Do not come near me, for I am holier than you! These are a smoke in My nostrils, a fire that burns all the day.

- 6 Behold, it is written before Me; I will not keep silence, but they will be recompensed, even recompensed into their bosom-
- 7 Your iniquities and the iniquities of your fathers together, says Yahweh: who have burned incense upon the mountains, and blasphemed Me upon the hills. Therefore their former work will be measured into their bosom.

In verse 4, we see they keep memorials for the dead. Have you ever heard of Halloween? We also see that they eat swine's flesh. Do you know of anyone who eats pork today and say they are Holy? Notice in **verse 5** how they say they are holier.

In **verse 7**, we see they practice iniquity, which is doing away with Yahweh's Sabbaths and other Laws (Daniyl 7:25).

● Isayah 66:17—

They who sanctify themselves, and purify themselves in the gardens, following after the priest in the midst of those who eat swine's flesh, that which is offered to Gods (elohim) and the rodent—will be consumed together: says Yahweh.

Yeremvah 44:19-

The women then said; When we burned incense to the Queen of Heaven and poured out drink offerings to her, it was not without our husbands' knowledge and consent that we made cakes for her, to worship her, and poured out drink offerings to her.

The Queen of Heaven spoken of here is the Easter Goddess, and the cakes are hot crossed buns. Did they celebrate Christmas too? Read on.

• Yeremyah 10:1-10-

1 Hear the word which Yahweh speaks concerning you, O house of Israyl.

2 This is what Yahweh says: Do not learn the way; religious practices, of the heathen; Gentile nations; and do not be deceived by the signs of heaven; though the heathen are deceived by them; using them to set their feasts.

3 For the *religious* customs of the peoples are vain; worthless! For one cuts a tree out of the forest, the work of the hands of the workman, with the ax.

4 They decorate it with silver and with gold; they fasten it with nails and with hammers, so that it will not move; topple

5 They are upright, like a palm tree, but they cannot speak; they must be carried, because they cannot go by themselves. Do not give them reverence! They cannot do evil, nor is it in them to do Righteousness!

6 There is none like You, O Yahweh! You are great, and Your Name is mighty in

- 7 Who should not reverence You, O Father of nations? Yes, that is Your due! Among all the wise *men* of the nations, and in all their kingdoms, there is none like You!
- 8 But they are altogether senseless; as one they are consumed by their foolishness; their stock is a doctrine of vanities; preaching about worthless Gods (elohim, teraphim) made of wood!
- 9 Silver beaten into plates is brought from Tarshish, and gold from Uphaz, the work of the craftsman and of the hands of the goldsmith. Blue and purple are used for decoration; all are made for use in worship, but are only the workmanship of skilled men.

10 But Yahweh is the true Mighty One! He is the Living and Everlasting Father! At His Judgment the earth will tremble, and the nations will not be able to prevail over the performance of His Judgment.

Do you know anyone who prays to the Creator Yahweh or do they pray to the

Yeremyah 23:26-27—

26 How long will this be in the heart of the prophets who prophesy lies? Yes, they are prophets of the deceit of their own minds;

27 Who devise; plan and scheme, to cause My People to forget My Name through their dreams, which they tell every man to his neighbor, just as their fathers have forgotten My Name for Baal; Lord.

Do you know anyone who worships in the name of Baal or the Lord?

The tribe of Yahdah and their king were placed in charge of Yerusalem and the temple, but they cut themselves off from Yahweh because of their iniquities and their sins. You just read of some of their sins—the practice of Easter, Halloween, and Christmas. Yahweh sent His Prophets to warn them of their evil, giving them an opportunity to repent. Many did, but the leaders did not.

● Isayah 58:1—

Cry aloud, spare not; lift up your voice like a trumpet, and show My People their transgressions, and the house of Yaaqob their sins.

Isavah 58:13-

If you turn away your foot from breaking the Sabbath: from doing your pleasure; your own business, your own pleasure, on My Holy Day, and call the Sabbath a delight; the Holy Day of Yahweh honorable, and will honor Him by not doing your own ways, nor finding your own pleasure, nor engaging in idle conversation.

● Isayah 59:1-4, 7—

1 Behold, Yahweh's Hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; nor His Ear heavy, that it cannot hear.

2 But your own iniquities have separated you from your Father; and your own sins have caused Him to hide His Face from you, so He will not listen.

3 For your hands are defiled with blood, and your fingers with iniquity; sin. Your lips have spoken lies, your tongue has muttered perverseness.

4 No one calls for justice, nor does any plead for Truth. They trust in vanity; confusion, and speak lies; scriptural untruths. They conceive mischief; trouble, and give birth to evil; sin.

7 Their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed innocent blood; their thoughts are thoughts of iniquity; wasting and destruction are in their paths.

The whole world is cut off from the Creator Yahweh today for the same

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reasons. This Prophecy of Isayah was given around 712 B.C.E. Yeremyah's Prophecy was given around 629–595 B.C.E.

• Daniyl 1:1-2—

1 In the third year of the reign of Yahyakim king of Yahdah, Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came against Yerusalem, and besieged it:

2 And Yahweh handed Yahyakim king of Yahdah over to him, with some of the articles of The House of Yahweh, which he carried into the land of Shinar to the house of his God (el); placing the articles into the treasure house of his God (el).

Daniyl is speaking of the taking over of Yerusalem and taking a huge number of people to Babylon. This is shown in the books of the kings.

• II Kings 24:11-16—

11 Then Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon himself came up to the city while his officers were besieging it.

12 Yahyakin king of Yahdah, his mother, his attendants, his nobles, and his officers surrendered to the king of Babylon. The king of Babylon, in the eighth year of his reign, took him prisoner.

13 He carried away from there all the treasures of The House of Yahweh and the treasures of the king's house. The articles of gold which Solomon, the king of Israyl, had made for The House of Yahweh he cut into pieces, just as Yahweh had said.

14 He also carried all Yerusalem into captivity—all the captains and the fighting men, all the craftsmen and artisans—10,000 captives. The only ones remaining were the poorest sort of the people of the land.

15 Nebuchadnezzar carried Yahyakin captive to Babylon. He also carried from Yerusalem to Babylon the king's mother,

his wives, his officials, and the leading men of the land.

16 All the fighting men: 7,000, and craftsmen and artisans: 1,000, all who were able and fit for war, these the king of Babylon brought captive to Babylon.

To fully understand this event, one must understand the history that led up to the many events of Yahweh teaching, leading, warning, and even chastising certain ones of Israyl in order to bring His Plan about in that land and among that family so the Prophecies of the Righteous Savior Yahshua could be fulfilled in Yerusalem.

Read the last part of **II Kings 24:14** again. They considered those who dwelled at Galilee to be the poorest, uneducated in all of Israyl. Galilee is where the Savior and His Apostles were born and raised. Yahweh's Plan was proceeding on schedule in Galilee.

Genesis 19 shows the wickedness that the nations had come to. Yahweh had said to Abraham to leave.

• Genesis 12:1-7—

- 1 Now Yahweh had said to Abram: Get out of your country, from your kindred and from your father's house, to a land that I will show you.
- 2 I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing.
- 3 And I will bless those who bless you, and he who curses you will bring curses upon himself; and in you shall all families of the earth be blessed.
- 4 So Abram departed as Yahweh had spoken unto him; and Lot went with him. And Abram was seventy-five years old

when he departed from Haran.

- 5 And Abram took Sarai, his wife, and Lot, his brother's son, and all their possessions they had accumulated, and the people they had acquired in Haran, and they went forth to go into the land of Canaan; and into the land of Canaan they came.
- 6 And Abram traveled through the land as far as the site of Shechem, to the Mighty Teacher, and the Canaanites were then in the land.
- 7 Then Yahweh appeared to Abram, and said: To your descendants I will give this land. And he built an altar there to Yahweh Who appeared to him.

After showing Abraham the land in which Yahshua Messiah would be born, Yahweh then sent the fathers of the families or tribes to the land of Egypt for a prophesied time. In this way, Yahweh kept Abraham's seed together and made them multiply. Over three million people came out of Egypt with Mosheh to the House of Yahweh in Galilee where they were taught Yahweh's Laws at Midian by Yethro, the Great Priest of Yahweh who was a relative by law to Mosheh. This is found in **Exodus Chapters 2, 3** and **18**. The date was around 1490 B.C.E.

Yethro stayed with Mosheh and the children of Abraham throughout their training period in the Kingdom of Yahweh and their trip into Canaan.

• Numbers 10:29-36—

29 Now Mosheh said to Hobab *his brother-in-law*, the son of Reuel the Midianite, Mosheh's father-in-law; We are setting out for the place about which

Yahweh said: I will give it to you. Come with us and we will treat you well; for Yahweh has promised great blessings upon Israyl.

- 30 But he said to him; I will not go, but I will return to my own land and to my kinsmen.
- 31 But Mosheh said; Please do not leave us. You know where we should camp in the desert, and you can be our eyes.
- 32 If you come with us we will share with you whatever blessings Yahweh gives us.
- 33 So they set out from the mountain of Yahweh and traveled for three days. The Ark of the Covenant of Yahweh went in front of them during those three days to search out a resting place for them.
- 34 And the cloud of Yahweh was above them by day when they went out from the camp
- 35 And it was whenever the Ark set out, Mosheh said; Rise up, O Yahweh! Let Your enemies be scattered, and let those who hate You flee in front of You.
- 36 Whenever it came to rest, he said; Return, O Yahweh, to the multitudes of the thousands of Israyl.

The tribes, which had become multitudes at that time, started moving into the lands around them. As they expanded, they also became separated. This is something Yahweh had not allowed until His Laws were fully taught to every tribe, giving each person the choice of Righteousness or the mixture of Righteousness and evil. As they expanded and separated, they moved into many other lands. They learned the languages and married the people of those lands. It wasn't long before the twelve tribes had become a multitude of nations as the Prophecy of **Genesis 48** shows.

• Genesis 48:19—

But his father refused, and said; I know, my son, I know. He, too, will become a people, and he too will become great; nevertheless, his younger brother will be greater than he, and his descendants will become a multitude of nations.

Remember, as the twelve tribes multiplied and separated, they became divided because they were without a Righteous Priest of Yahweh to hold them together. The Faith given to them by Mosheh was soon mixed with the paganism of the nations they had mingled and bred with. Although many of the people of the twelve tribes remembered the Faith Yahweh had given them, many others forgot it and started mixing with pagan religions of God (El) and Baal (the Lord) worship,

such as you find today in Christianity—the Catholic church.

Note the following timeline.

- 1897 B.C.E.: **Genesis 19**—the wickedness of the nations
- 1491 B.C.E.: **Exodus 12**—exodus from Egypt
- •1112 B.C.E.: **I Samuyl 8**—tribes reject Yahweh
- 601 B.C.E.: **II Kings 24**—tribes fight against each other

Babylon—The Retraining Program In The Schools Of Higher Learning

Babylon means confusion. It has always been synonymous with the religion of the mixture that Yahweh shows in His Plan from the beginning. There have always been two religions (trees) in Yahweh's Plan that He uses to test those He chooses and ordains to bring forth His Plan.

The Two Trees

Genesis 2:9—

And out of the ground Yahweh made every tree grow that is pleasant to the sight, and desirable for food. In the midst of the garden *were* the Tree of Life and *also* the tree of the knowledge of Righteousness and evil.

The Plan of Yahweh is shown in the beginning. The Apostle Yahchanan was shown, and inspired to write about, the Plan of Yahweh given in the beginning.

● Yahchanan 1:1-3—

1 In the beginning was the Plan of

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Yahweh, and the Plan was with Yahweh, and the Plan was Yahweh's.

- 2 The same *Plan* was in the beginning with Yahweh.
- 3 All things were done according to it, and without it nothing was done, that was done.

Yahweh's Plan is to allow two religions. One tree is shown as the Tree of Life, which brings forth 613 Laws that would lead one to total Righteousness and Eternal Life—Life by Righteousness.

• Deuteronomy 30:15-20—

15 See, I have set before you this day <u>Life by Righteousness</u>, and death by destruction—

16 In that I command you this day to love Yahweh your Father, by walking in *all* His Ways, by keeping His Laws, His Statutes, and His Judgments, so that you may live and multiply, and so Yahweh your Father may bless you in the land which you go in to possess.

17 But if your heart turns away, and you are not obedient, and you are drawn away to submit to Gods (elohim), to worship them by serving them—

18 I declare to you this day that you will surely perish; you will not prolong your days in the land which you cross over the Yardan to possess.

19 I call heaven and earth as witnesses against you this day, *that I* have set before you Life and death, blessings and curses. Therefore choose life, so both you and your children may live;

20 So you may love Yahweh your Father, by listening to Him, and *then* obeying Him. Hold fast to Him, for He is your life. He will *also* give you many years in the land He vowed to give to your fathers; to Abraham, Isaac, and Yaaqob.

The breaking of Yahweh's Laws is sin.

• I Yahchanan 3:4—

Whoever commits sin, transgresses also the Laws; for sin is the transgression of the Laws.

Sin cuts you off from Yahweh and places a debt upon you that only death can pay.

• Isayah 59:1-2—

Behold, Yahweh's Hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; nor His Ear heavy, that it cannot hear.

2 But your *own* iniquities have separated you from your Father; and your *own* sins have *caused Him* to hide *His* Face from you, so He will not listen.

Romans 6:16—

Do you not know that to whom you yield yourselves as servants to obey, his servants you are whom you obey—whether of sin, which leads to death, or of obedience, which leads to Righteousness?

Practicing Yahweh's Laws brings one Eternal Life through repentance,

conversion, and the Lamb of Yahweh paying our back debt.

• Acts 3:19-20-

19 Repent therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out; that times of refreshing may come from the Presence of Yahweh;

20 And that He may send Yahshua, the Messiah Who was preached to you,

• Revelation 22:12-14-

12 And behold, I come quickly, and My Reward is with Me, to give every man according as his work will be.

13 I am the First and the Last, the

Beginning and the End.

14 Blessed are those who keep His Laws, that they may have right to the Tree of Life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

That's the Teaching of the Tree of Life. The other tree shown in the beginning is the tree of the mixture of Righteousness and evil.

• Genesis 2:9-

And out of the ground Yahweh made every tree grow that is pleasant to the sight, and desirable for food. In the midst of the garden were the Tree of Life and also the tree of the knowledge of Righteousness and evil.

The tree of the mixture of Righteousness and evil does not repent of sin. Those who partake of this tree say they repent, but it's not of sin because they keep sinning every weekly Sabbath. Breaking Yahweh's Laws is sin.

• I Yahchanan 3:4—

Whoever commits sin, transgresses also the Laws; for sin is the transgression of the Laws.

Practicing breaking Yahweh's Laws makes one a servant of Satan.

• I Yahchanan 3:8—

He who commits sin is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of Yahweh was manifested; that He might destroy the works of the devil.

Notice this religion or tree is a mixture that brings destruction.

Deuteronomy 30:15-20—

15 See, I have set before you this day Life by Righteousness, and death by destruction-

16 In that I command you this day to love Yahweh your Father, by walking in all His Ways, by keeping His Laws, His Statutes, and His Judgments, so that you may live and multiply, and so Yahweh your Father may bless you in the land which you go in to possess.

17 But if your heart turns away, and you are not obedient, and you are drawn away to submit to Gods (elohim), to worship them by serving them-

18 I declare to you this day that you

will surely perish; you will not prolong your days in the land which you cross over the Yardan to possess.

19 I call heaven and earth as witnesses against you this day, that I have set before you Life and death, blessings and curses. Because you are free agents to make your own choice between Righteousness and evil—therefore choose life, so both you and your children may live;

20 So you may love Yahweh your Father, by listening to Him, and then obeying Him. Hold fast to Him, for He is your life. He will also give you many years in the land He vowed to give to your fathers; to Abraham, Isaac, and Yaaqob.

The Tree of Life was preached by Abel, the first Righteous Priest of Yahweh. The tree (mixture) of Righteousness and evil was preached by Cain, whose example all the world has followed. Yahweh said to Cain, if you do not practice Righteousness, sin lies at your door and you must overcome it.

• Genesis 4:5-7—

5 But He did not honor Cain and his offering. And Cain was very angry, and his countenance fell.

6 So Yahweh said to Cain: Why are you

angry? Why are you downcast?

7 If you do Righteousness, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do Righteousness, sin is crouching at your door. The desire to sin is with you, but you must overcome it!

Sin is the breaking of Yahweh's Laws. Satan is the killer and deceiver.

• Genesis 3:1-4-

1 Now the serpent was more subtle and crafty than any beast of the field which Yahweh had made. And she said to the woman; Has Yahweh indeed said: You shall not eat of every tree of the garden?

2 And the woman said to the serpent; We may eat the fruit of the trees of the

3 But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, Yahweh has said: You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, or you will die.

4 And the serpent said to the woman; You will not surely die.

Many religions today persuade people all over the world to believe this same lie and the murderers who teach it.

Yahchanan 8:44—

You are of your teacher who is Satan the devil, and whatever she who is your teacher desires, you will do. She was a murderer from the beginning, and remained not in the Truth, because there is no Truth in her. Therefore, when you speak your falsehoods, you speak her words, because she is a liar, and the teacher of all lies!

• I Yahchanan 3:7-8, 10-11, 15-

7 Little children, let no man deceive you; he who practices Righteousness is Righteous, just as He is Righteous.

8 He who commits sin is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of Yahweh was manifested; that He might destroy the works of the devil.

10 In this the Children of Yahweh and the children of the devil are manifest. Whoever does not practice Righteousness is not of Yahweh, and he does not love his neighbor!

11 For this is the Message that you heard from the beginning, that we should

love one another.

15 Whoever hates his neighbor is a murderer; and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him.

Genesis 3:5-7-

5 For He knows that in the day you eat of it, your eyes will be opened, and you will be as Gods (elohim), knowing Righteousness and evil.

6 So when the woman saw that the tree was desirable for food, that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate.

7 Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they realized that they had sinned; they had violated Yahweh's Laws. Because they had not kept Yahweh's Laws, they were afraid.

The Deceptive Tree

We are warned about deception because it didn't stay with Cain only.

Mattithyah 7:13-20—

13 Enter in through the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and many are those who go that way.

14 Because straight is the gate, and narrow is the way which leads to life, and few there are who find it.

15 <u>Beware of false prophets</u> who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

16 You will know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes from thorns, or figs from thistles?

17 Likewise, every Righteous tree brings forth Righteous fruit; but a tree of evil brings forth fruit of iniquity.

18 A Righteous tree cannot bring forth fruit of iniquity, nor can a tree of evil bring forth fruits of Righteousness.

19 Every tree which does not bring forth Righteous fruit is cut down, and cast into the fire.

20 Therefore, by their fruits you will know them.

Revelation 20:11-15—

11 And I saw a great white Throne, and Him Who sat on it, from Whose face the powers of the earth and the powers of the heavens, the Gods (elohim), were driven away; for the verdict was reached that there is no place for them.

12 And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before Yahweh. And the books were opened; and another book was opened, which is The Book of Life. And the dead were judged out of those things

which were written in the books, according to their works.

13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and sheol; *the grave*, delivered up the dead which were in them. And they were judged, every man, according to his works.

14 And death and sheol were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

15 And whoever was not found written in The Book of Life was <u>cast into the lake</u> of fire

Revelation 22:12-15—

12 And behold, I come quickly, and My Reward *is* with Me, to give every man according as his work will be.

13 I am the First and the Last, the

Beginning and the End.

14 <u>Blessed are those who keep His Laws</u>, that they may have right to the Tree of Life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

15 For outside *are* dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and worshipers of Gods (elohim) and everyone *who professes* to love, yet practices breaking the Laws.

• I Yahchanan 2:4—

He who says: I know Him, but does not keep His Laws, is a liar, and the Truth is not in him.

• I Yahchanan 3:4, 7-8, 10—

4 Whoever commits sin, transgresses also the Laws; for <u>sin is the transgression</u> <u>of the Laws</u>.

7 Little children, let no man deceive you; he who practices Righteousness is Righteous, just as He is Righteous.

8 He who commits sin is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of Yahweh was manifested; that He might destroy the works of the devil.

10 In this the Children of Yahweh and the children of the devil are manifest. Whoever does not practice Righteousness is not of Yahweh, and he does not love his neighbor!

The Same Message From The Beginning (Genesis)

I Yahchanan 3:11—

For this is the Message that you heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.

The Plan of Yahweh will not change. Those who follow the Tree of Life, The House of Yahweh, by practicing Yahweh's Laws will receive Life Eternal. That's Yahweh's Plan of Life.

●Yahchanan 1:4, 12-13, 17, 29-30, 36—

4 In *this Plan* was life, and that life was the light to mankind.

12 But as many as received Him, to those He gave authority to become the Sons of Yahweh to those who believe the Testimony of Yahweh—

13 Who are begotten, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of Yahweh.

17 For the Laws were given through Mosheh, that the Truth and Salvation should come through Yahshua Messiah.

29 The next day Yahchanan saw Yahshua coming toward him, and said; Behold! The Lamb of Yahweh Who takes away the sin of the world!

30 This is He of Whom I said; The One coming after me, has become in front of

me, because He is my Head.

36 And watching Yahshua as He walked, he said; Behold the Lamb of Yahweh!

• Acts 3:19—

Repent therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out; that times of refreshing may come from the Presence of Yahweh.

Don't let Satan deceive you.

● I Yahchanan 3:7-8—

7 Little children, <u>let no man deceive you</u>; he who practices Righteousness is Righteous, just as He is Righteous.

8 He who commits sin is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of Yahweh was manifested; that He might destroy the works of the devil.

Revelation 12:9—

And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the devil, and Satan, who deceives the whole world. She was cast out into the earth, and her angels were cast out with her.

Deceptions From Babylon—The Schools Of Higher Learning

In order to understand, you must remember that besides knowing about the two trees in Yahweh's Great Plan, you must believe the Prophets.

• Luke 24:25-27—

25 Then He said to them: O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the Prophets have spoken!

26 Was it not necessary for the Messiah to have suffered these things before entering into His glory?

27 And beginning at Mosheh; *the Laws*, and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.

• Isavah 8:20—

To the Laws and to the Prophecies: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them.

Please notice what this is saying to you. If preachers or deceivers do not teach you to obey Yahweh's Laws, they do not teach you Salvation. If they are not spoken of by the Prophets of old as being ordained by Yahweh for a certain work, they are given no <u>Light</u> or inspiration from Yahweh.

• Amosyah 3:1-2—

1 Hear this word which Yahweh has spoken against you, O children of Israyl, against the whole family which I brought up from the land of Egypt, saying:

2 You only have I known of all the families of the earth; therefore, I will call you to account for all your iniquities.

If you will believe the words of the Prophets, you will not be deceived. Live the Plan of Yahweh with me as Yahweh unfolds it in the coming months. Let's look again at the Prophecies of Daniyl.

• Daniyl 1:1-2—

1 In the third year of the reign of Yahyakim king of Yahdah, Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came against Yerusalem, and besieged it;

2 And Yahweh handed Yahyakim king of Yahdah over to him, with some of the articles of The House of Yahweh, which he carried into the land of Shinar to the house of his God (el); placing the articles into the treasure house of his God (el).

Babylon is often connected in people's minds with babel and Nimrod. However, Nimrod was not the name of a man. It is a system of what was considered as higher learning. The word babel or the tower of babel comes from the <u>Hebrew</u> root word <u>balal</u> which means to confound. It is referenced to the confusion of tongues at the tower of babel to scatter the people throughout the earth. Notice the sons of Cush are given in:

• Genesis 10:7—

The sons of Cush were Seba, Havilah, Sabtah, Raamah, and Sabtechah; and the sons of Raamah were Sheba and Dedan.

The Hebrew says that Cush <u>fathered</u> Nimrod.

Genesis 10:8—

Cush begot Nimrod; he began to be a mighty one on the earth.

Nimrod is not a son. The sons of Cush are shown in **Genesis 10:7**. Nimrod was not a man. Nimrod is a religious system, established by Cush, that teaches rebellion against Yahweh. It teaches rebellion against Yahweh's Laws as seen in **Genesis Chapter 3** where we see Adam and Eve were caused to sin.

• Genesis 3:1-7—

1 Now the serpent was more subtle *and* crafty than any beast of the field which Yahweh had made. And she said to the woman; Has Yahweh indeed said: You shall not eat of every tree of the garden?

2 And the woman said to the serpent; We may eat the fruit of the trees of the garden:

- 3 But of the fruit of the tree which *is* in the midst of the garden, Yahweh has said: You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, or you will die.
- 4 And the serpent said to the woman; You will not surely die.
- 5 For He knows that in the day you eat of it, your eyes will be opened, and you will be as Gods (elohim), knowing Righteousness and evil.
- 6 So when the woman saw that the tree was desirable for food, that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate.
- 7 Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they realized that they had sinned; they had violated Yahweh's Laws. *Because* they had not kept Yahweh's Laws, they were afraid.

The tower of babel was started and then the people scattered. The building stopped because their language was changed and they could no longer understand each other so they separated. Genesis 10:8-10 distinguishes the people who founded the city from the Semitic Hebrews who afterward possessed it and made it a strong, tyrannical empire that captured and re-educated their captives in their system of so-called higher learning and rebellion.

It's anyone's guess, but the beginnings of the city of Babylon are unknown except for the Inspired Scripture, **Genesis 10:10**, and the other hints Yahweh gives us in the Inspired Writings of the Prophets and Apostles. Remember:

• II Kings 24:13—

He carried away from there all the treasures of The House of Yahweh and the treasures of the king's house. The articles of gold which Solomon, the king of Israyl, had made for The House of Yahweh he cut into pieces, just as Yahweh had said.

<u>Eleven years after</u> II Kings 24:13 took place under the reign of Yahyakin, the city and temple were totally destroyed.

• II Kings 25:8-15—

- 8 In the Fifth Moon, on the seventh day of the moon, which was the nineteenth year of King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon, Nebuzaradan, captain of the king's guard, an official of the king of Babylon, arrived in Yerusalem.
- 9 He burned The House of Yahweh, the king's house, and all the houses of Yerusalem. Every important structure he burned with fire.
- 10 All the army of the Chaldeans accompanying the captain of the royal guard, broke down the walls around Yerusalem.
- 11 Nebuzaradan, the captain of the royal guard, then carried away captive the rest of the people who remained in the city—

- the remainder of the people and the defectors who had deserted to the king of Babylon.
- 12 But the captain left behind some of the poorest sort of people of the land to work the vineyards and fields.
- 13 The bronze pillars in The House of Yahweh, the carts, and the bronze Sea that were in The House of Yahweh, the Chaldeans broke in pieces, and carried the bronze to Babylon.
- 14 They carried off the pots, shovels, wick trimmers, ladles, and all the bronze articles used by the priests in the service at *The* House of *Yahweh*.
- 15 The censers and sprinkling bowls all that were made of gold or silver—the captain of the royal guard carried away.

The people and kings that fought against the tiny nations of Israyl and Yerusalem were, in fact, the twelve tribes that had scattered abroad, multiplied, formed other tribes, chose kings and built empires. These empires took the empires of those settled on the land before them.

The Babylonian kingdom was formed from Hebrews who left the land of Israyl by the millions. Those Hebrews rebelled against Yahweh and the tribe of Yahdah. They worshipped the same Gods and Goddesses that are worshipped by the Catholic church today. This is a Scriptural and historical fact.

The tribes that made up Babylon kept striving to wipe out the worship of Yahweh and His Laws in Israyl and all other nations too. In fact, they brought attack after attack against Israyl. They took captives and carried them to Babylon to be re-educated. They also took their book; their literature. They installed kings in Yerusalem and Israyl that were loyal to Babylon and its Nimrod system of learning, teaching, and worshipping Gods and Goddesses of illegal/uncontrollable lust. They thought they had wiped out the worship of Yahweh until a Book of the Laws of Yahweh was found and brought to the king of Yahdah.

• II Kings 22:8—

Hilkiyah the High Priest said to Shaphan the scribe; I have <u>found The Book of the</u> <u>Laws in The House of Yahweh</u>. So Hilkiyah gave the book to Shaphan, and he read it.

This took place during the time period of about 641 B.C.E. to 610 B.C.E.

At this point the true religion that brings Salvation started again in the land of Israyl in Yerusalem. This was the time period of Yeremyah the Great Prophet of Yahweh. Notice:

• II Kings 22:11-20—

- 11 As soon as the king heard the words of The Book of the Laws, he tore his clothes.
- 12 Then the king gave a command to Hilkiyah, the High Priest, to Ahikam, the son of Shaphan, to Achbor, the son of Micahyah, to Shaphan the scribe, and to Asayah, an official of the king, and said;
- 13 Go, inquire of Yahweh for me, for the people, and for all Yahdah, about the words of this Book that has been found. The Judgment that Yahweh will bring concerning us will be greatly zealous, because our fathers have not obeyed the words of this Book to do according to all that is written concerning us.
- 14 So Hilkiyah the High Priest, Ahikam, Achbor, Shaphan, and Asayah went to Huldah the prophetess, the wife of Shallum, the son of Tikvah, the son of Harhas, keeper of the wardrobe. They lived in Yerusalem, in the Second Quarter. There they spoke with them.
- 15 *Shallum and Huldah* said to them; Tell the man who sent you to us;
- 16 This is what Yahweh, the Father of Israyl, says: Behold, disaster will be brought on this place and on its people—according to all that is written in The Book of The Laws that the king of Yahdah has read—
- 17 Because they have forsaken Me and burned incense to hinder Gods (elohim), and acted in defiance of Me by all the images of their Gods (elohim) that their hands have made; My Judgment will be zealously brought because of this place, and it will not be quenched.
- 18 But to the king of Yahdah, who sent you to inquire of Yahweh, speak to him, and say; This is what Yahweh, the Father of Israyl, says concerning the words you have heard:
- 19 Because your heart; mind, was submissive, and you humbled yourself in front of Yahweh—when you heard what I had spoken against this place; Yahdah, and against its people, that they would become a desolation and a curse—and you tore your clothes and wept in front of Me, I also have heard you, says Yahweh.
- 20 Therefore, you will be gathered to your fathers, and you will be buried in peace. Your eyes will not see all the disaster that I am going to bring upon this place. So they took this word back to the king.

Oh, if only the kings of the earth were to repent as the king of Israyl did at that time under the guidance of Yeremyah the Prophet of Yahweh.

The Forbidden Tree Of Genesis 2:9—What they worshipped Among the Twelve Tribes Scattered Throughout Babylon

Remember that Babylon was made up of the twelve tribes. Those who try to

get you to believe differently only want you to believe their theories. Notice the copy below from *Unger's Bible Dictionary*.

CHALDE'A (kal-dē'a; from Accad. kaldu). Originally a small territory in southern Babylonia at the head of the Persian Gulf, but later, after the neo-Babylonian Empire-of Nebuchadnezzar II (605-562 B.C.), the term came to include practically all of Babylonia extending N of Hit southward to the gulf.

CHALDEAN (kal-de'an). A native of Chaldea. See Babylonia. The Chaldeans were a warlike, aggressive people from the mountains of Kurdistan. Apparently they were Haldians (or Khaldians), the inhabitants of Urartu, that is, Ararat for Armenia. The ancient Chaldeans are mentioned in the Babylonian inscriptions. They began to ap-

The facts in the Inspired Scriptures are the only true history. It identifies the Hebrew people by their religion. The Gods and Goddesses they learned about in Egypt they brought with them when they scattered throughout the land. As was with Cain and Abel, the enmity between the Righteousness of Yahweh and the evil of Lucifer, so was the hatred between the tribes of Babylon—the Hebrew people—and the tribes of the tiny land of Israyl who actually taught Yahweh's Laws at the temple. At a set time, the written Laws of Mosheh (Yahweh's 613 Laws) were taught. Yahshua spoke of this in:

Mattithyah 23:1-3—

- 1 Then Yahshua spoke to the multitudes and to His Disciples,
- 2 Saying: The scribes and the Pharisees are appointed to Mosheh's office; teachers of Yahweh's Law,
- 3 Therefore, obey and practice everything they tell you to observe, but do not imitate their works; for they preach but they do not practice!

King Solomon traded with the tribes of Israyl that were scattered abroad and allowed them to bring God worship into Israyl. Get the history.

• I Kings 4:20-21, 24-25, 29-31—

20 Yahdah and Israyl were as numerous as the sand on the seashore for multitude. They ate, they drank, and they were joyous.

- 21 Solomon reigned over all the kingdoms from the River Euphrates to the land of the Philistines, as far as the border of Egypt. These kingdoms brought tribute and were subject to Solomon all the days of his life.
- 24 He ruled over all the kingdoms west of the River *Euphrates*, from Tiphsah to Gaza, and he had peace on every border all around him.
- 25 Yahdah and Israyl lived in safety, each man under his own vine and fig tree,

from Dan to as far as Beersheba, during Solomon's lifetime.

- 29 Yahweh gave Solomon wisdom, exceedingly great insight, and a breadth of understanding as infinite as the sands upon the seashore.
- 30 The wisdom of Solomon surpassed the wisdom of all the men of the East, and all the wisdom of Egypt.
- 31 He was wiser than all other men, including Ethan the Ezrahite, and Heman, Calcol, and Darda, the sons of Mahol. And his fame spread to all the surrounding nations.

The twelve tribes that had scattered abroad were not known as Israylites. In many cases, as history shows, they took on the names of those who had settled the lands. They became known by the name of their location or the leader of a tribe. The Scriptural fact is, portions of the twelve tribes entered and mixed with God worshipping settlements, then took control of them and built empires after the Nimrod system.

Don't be deceived, the only division that took place during the time of babel was the language.

• Genesis 11:9—

Therefore its name is called Babel, because there Yahweh <u>confounded the languages</u> of all the earth.

• Genesis 11:1-8-

1 Now the whole earth had one language and one speech.

2 And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east; *the beginning*, that they found a plain in the land of Shinar; *Babylon*, and they settled there.

3 Then they said to one another; Come, let us make bricks and burn *them* thoroughly. They had brick for stone, and they had bitumen for mortar.

- 4 And they said; Come, let us build ourselves a city, and a tower, whose top *is* in the heavens. Let us make a name for ourselves, lest we be scattered abroad over the face of the whole earth.
- 5 But Yahweh came down to see the city and the tower which the sons of men had built
- 6 And Yahweh said: Indeed the people *are* one and they all have one language, and this is what they begin to do. After this, nothing that they purpose to do will be withheld from them.
- 7 Come now! I will go down, and there I will confuse their language, that they may not understand one another's speech.
- 8 So Yahweh <u>scattered them abroad</u> from there over the face of all the earth; <u>and they ceased building the city</u>.

Yahweh did not create another race of people, He only divided the languages of the people who already existed. These people started settlements. These settlements gave themselves names and groups of wandering Israylites joined them. The names of many of the settlements were changed to Hebrew names, but not all of them.

The Languages

The language spoken in some settlements changed to Hebrew, but most of the languages became a mixture of Hebrew and the native language of the settlement. Most true scholars know that the Semitic language consists of African, Asian, Hebrew, Arabic and others. All of this brings us to the city called Babylon.

Babylon

Babylon was not just a city among other cities. It was a symbol of political aspiration and cultural power. It was also a city where several different religions made their headquarters, including the Pharisees.

As in Babylon, many Gods were worshipped in Israyl and Yahweh was being phased out by the leading religious factions, the Pharisees and Sadducees. Yes, in Babylon, Yerusalem, and Israyl the Name and Laws of Yahweh were being removed.

During the time of the kings, after King Solomon, the twelve tribes fought each other in Israyl. At the same time, they built controlling units in other lands, such as Babylon. In fact, the Babylonian kingdom was divided and fights took place between the colonies that were made up of kings and subjects.

As the Pharisees persuaded more and more Israylites to come and live in Babylon, the empire grew and developed a great army that came under the rule of the Pharisees. This took place shortly after the days of Daniyl. I will prove this in a later letter.

In the days of Yeremyah, those who worshipped Yahweh were persecuted and driven out of Yerusalem by the Pharisees. The Pharisees controlled the religions of Yerusalem. As the Great Prophet Daniyl showed, their system of religions devoured the whole earth. Their practice is clearly shown by the Prophets as early as the days of Solomon. Solomon, for whatever reason, possibly being blind to what was going on with the priests, who

were later known in Israyl as Pharisees, Sadducees and Essenes, allowed God worship to abound in Israyl. The God worship became stronger after Solomon died.

The Worship— Christmas And Easter

• I Kings 11:5-8—

- 5 Because Solomon went after Ashtoreth, the goddess of the Phoenicians (Sidonians), and after Milcom (the God; *el*, Molech), the abomination of the Ammonites.
- 6 Solomon did evil; *following the Gods* (*elohim*), in the eyes of Yahweh, and did not completely follow Yahweh, as his father David had done.
- 7 Then Solomon built a high place for *the God (el)* Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, on a hill east of Yerusalem, and also for *the God (el)* Molech, the abomination of the people of Ammon.
- 8 He did the same thing for all his foreign wives, who burned incense and sacrificed to their Gods (elohim).

The time period spoken of here ran from around 984 B.C.E. to 975 B.C.E. Around 641 B.C.E. most of the Israylites had forgotten Yahweh's Laws and His Name. Around 641 B.C.E. was also the time period of King Yoshiyah, an eight-year-old boy who reigned thirty-one years in Yerusalem. During his reign, he fought against the Pharisees, who weren't known by that name at that time, but their teachings identified them, just as they do in their children today, 2010. Notice:

• II Kings 22:1-2, 8-11—

- 1 Yoshiyah; Foundation of Yahweh, was eight years old when he became king, and he reigned thirty-one years in Yerusalem. His mother's name was Yedidah, the daughter of Adayah of Bozkath.
- 2 He did right in the Eyes of Yahweh; serving Yahweh, and walked in all the ways of his father David. He did not turn away to the right nor to the left.
- 8 Hilkiyah the High Priest said to Shaphan the scribe; I have found The Book of the Laws in The House of Yahweh. So Hilkiyah gave the book to Shaphan, and he read it.
- 9 Shaphan the scribe returned to the king, and reported to him, saying; Your servants have counted the money found in The House of Yahweh, and they have given it to the overseers and workers at The House of Yahweh.
- 10 Then Shaphan the scribe informed the king, and said; Hilkiyah, the High Priest, has given me a Book. And Shaphan read it to the king.
- 11 As soon as the king heard the words of The Book of the Law, he tore his clothes.

Get this, Yoshiyah was eight years old when he took the throne and in the eighteenth year of his reign, he still knew nothing about the Laws of Yahweh. II Kings Chapter 22 also shows us that the priests who were running the priesthood in Yerusalem were also ignorant about the Laws of Yahweh. The Law of Yahweh requires a king to acquire a copy of the Laws from the Priest for himself to live by and to guide his subjects.

Notice the God-Lord-Baal worship that had replaced the worship of Yahweh and practicing His Laws in Israyl.

• II Kings 23:1-15—

- 1 Then the king dispatched messengers to gather all the elders of Yahdah and Yerusalem to him.
- 2 Then the king went up to The House of Yahweh, along with all the men of Yahdah, and all the people of Yerusalem—the Priests, the Prophets, and all the people, both great and small. He read in their hearing all the words of The Book of the Covenant; *The Book of the Law*, which had been found in The House of Yahweh.
- 3 Then the king stood by a column and renewed the Covenant in front of Yahweh—to follow Yahweh, to keep His Laws, His Testimonies, and His Statutes, with all *their* hearts and being: to perform the words of this covenant which is written in this Book. Then all the people vowed to keep the covenant.
- 4 Then the king commanded Hilkiyah, the High Priest, the priests of the second rank; *the ordinary priests*, and the door-keepers, to bring out of The House of Yahweh all the articles that were made for Baal, for Asherah, and for all the host of heaven. He burned them outside Yerusalem in the fields of the Kidron Valley, and took their ashes to Beth-El.
- 5 He expelled the pagan priests ordained by the kings of Yahdah to burn incense on the high places of the cities of Yahdah, and on those around Yerusalem those pagan priests who burned incense to Baal, to the sun, to the moon, to the constellations of all the hosts of heaven.
- 6 He took the <u>Asherah</u> pole; the sacred pole, out of The House of Yahweh, brought it to the Kidron Valley outside Yerusalem, burned it in the Kidron Valley, and ground that abominable wooden representation of the goddess (elohim) into ashes, then threw the ashes over the graves of the common people.
- 7 He tore down the houses of the qedeshim; *men practicing sodomy and prostitution in religious rituals*, that were in The House of Yahweh—where the women wove the houses for <u>Asherah</u>.
- 8 Yoshiyah brought all the priests from the cities of Yahdah, and defiled and desecrated the high places where the priests had burned incense, from Geba to Beersheba. He broke down the high places at the gates—at the entrance to the Gate

of Yahshua, the governor of the city, which is on the left of the city gate.

9 Although the priests of the high places did not approach the altar of Yahweh in Yerusalem, they did eat unleavened bread among their fellow priests.

10 He defiled and desecrated Tophet, which is in the Valley of Ben-Hinnom, so no man might make his son or his daughter pass through the fire; *sacrifice his son or his daughter*, to Molech.

11 Then he removed from the entrance to The House of Yahweh the horses that the kings of Yahdah had dedicated to the sun. They were in the court near the room of an official named Nathan-Melech. Yoshiyah then burned the chariots of the sun with fire.

12 The altars on the roof of the upper room of Ahaz, which the kings of Yahdah had set up, and the altars that Menasheh built in the two courts of The House of Yahweh, the king tore down, removed the debris, and threw it into the Kidron Valley.

- 13 Then the king defiled and desecrated the high places east of Yerusalem, on the south of the Mount of Corruption, which Solomon king of Israyl had built for Ashtoreth; Asherah-Ishtar-Easter, the abomination of the Phoenicians (Sidonians), for Chemosh, the abomination of the Moabites, and for Milcom; Molech, the abomination of the people of Ammon.
- 14 He broke the sacred pillars; masseboth, representing <u>Baal; the Lord</u>, and cut down the Asherah poles; the sacred poles, and covered the sites with human bones.
- 15 Even the altars at Beth-El, the high place built by Yeroboam son of Nebat, who had caused Israyl to commit sin—even those altars and that high place he destroyed. He burned the high place, ground it to dust, and burned the Asherah Pole also.

Compare:

• II Kings 23:26-27—

26 Nevertheless, they did not turn away from acting in great defiance against Yahweh, Who turned away many times because they had forsaken Him. Yahdah too had acted defiantly against Yahweh, and He turned away because they too had forsaken Him because of all that Menasheh had done as an act of defiance against Him.

27 So Yahweh had said: Yahdah will also be removed from My sight, just as Israyl was removed; and this city Yerusalem which I have chosen, and this House, about which I said; My Name shall be there—will be cast off.

Easter and Christmas, part of Baal (Lord) worship, are big money making holidays promoted by schools of higher learning that teach how to make money and bring in taxes. These same schools were built in the days of Solomon.

• I Kings 11:4-8—

4 When Solomon became old, his wives turned his heart after hinder gods (elohim);

and his heart was not perfect with Yahweh his Father, as the heart of his father David, had been.

- 5 Because Solomon went after Ashtoreth, the goddess of the Phoenicians (Sidonians), and after Milcom (the god; *el*, Molech), the abomination of the Ammonites.
- 6 Solomon did evil; *following the gods* (*elohim*), in the Eyes of Yahweh, and did not completely follow Yahweh, as his father David had done.
- 7 Then Solomon built a <u>high place</u> for *the God (el)* Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, on a hill east of Yerusalem, and also for *the god (el)* Molech, the abomination of the people of Ammon.

8 He did the same thing for all his foreign wives, who burned incense and sacrificed to their gods (elohim).

This worship got stronger up until the days of Yeremyah and King Yoshiyah who repented of God (El), Lord (Baal) worship and turned many of those of Israyl back to Righteousness. This bit of history took place for the purpose of setting the stage for the Prophesied Savior and to prove what Yahweh's Laws of Righteousness can do when they are taught to the people, as the Great Prophet Yeremyah was inspired to write.

• Yeremyah 23:21-22—

21 I have not sent these prophets, yet they ran; I have not spoken of them, yet they prophesied.

22 But if they had stood in My Counsel, and had caused My People to hear My Words; *the Laws and the Prophets*, then they would have turned them from their evil way, and from the evil of their doings.

In the days of Yahshua Messiah the Pharisees had the Laws, but they did not keep the Laws, and they persecuted anyone who dared to teach them in Yerusalem. This is seen in:

Yahchanan 7:19—

Were not the Laws given to you through Mosheh? And yet none of you keep the Laws! Why do you seek to kill Me?

Again, notice the judgment and the Prophecy.

II Kings 23:27—

So Yahweh had said: I will also <u>remove</u> <u>Yahdah</u> from My sight, just as I have removed Israyl, <u>and I will cast off this city</u> <u>Yerusalem which I have chosen, and the House, about which I said: My Name shall be there.</u>

Notice that Yahdah is prophesied to be removed from the land of Israyl, just as Israyl was. Of the twelve tribes, only Yahdah was left in Israyl. Where were the other eleven tribes of Israyl? There are many books on the market, at this

time, concerning the lost sheep of the house of Israyl, but the Scriptures show us best.

The guesswork shown in dictionaries and encyclopedias uses words and phrases such as "perhaps" or "it could be". This simply means that they don't know but are willing to guess. The facts are prophesied in:

• Genesis 48:14-19—

14 But Israyl reached out his right hand and put it on Ephraim's head, though he was the younger, and crossing his arms, he put his left hand on Menasheh's head, even though Menasheh was the firstborn,

15 And he blessed Yahseph, and said; May the *Heavenly* Father before Whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac walked; Yahweh Who has been my Shepherd all my life to this very day; the Malak delivering me from all harm: May He bless these boys.

16 May my name be called upon them, and the name of my fathers, Abraham and Isaac. May they increase greatly in the midst of the earth.

17 When Yahseph saw that his father placed his right hand on Ephraim's head, it was displeasing in his sight. He took hold of his father's hand to move it from Ephraim's head to the head of Menasheh,

18 And Yahseph said; Not so, my father, for this one is my firstborn. Put your right hand upon his head.

19 But his father refused, and said; I know, my son, I know. He, too, will become a people, and he too will become great; nevertheless, his younger brother will be greater than he, and his descendants will become a multitude of nations.

Genesis 49 shows the evil traits these nations would have in the Last Days. Yahweh is still dealing with this whole family that spread throughout the earth and became nations. Carefully read the Prophecy in Genesis 49 and believe verse 1.

• Genesis 49:1-28—

- 1 Then Yaaqob called for his sons, and said; Gather together, <u>so I may tell you what will befall you in the Last Days</u>.
- 2 Gather together and listen, you sons of Yaaqob; listen to Israyl your father.
- 3 Reuben, you are my firstborn, my might, the first sign of my strength, excelling in honor, exceeding in rank;
- 4 Turbulent like water, you will no longer excel; for you went up onto your father's bed, onto my couch and defiled it.
- 5 Simeon and Levi are brothers; their swords are <u>weapons of violence</u>.
- 6 Let me not enter their council. Let my glory not be joined to their assembly; for in anger they killed a man, and for their pleasure they hamstrung an ox.
- 7 Cursed be their anger, so fierce; and their fury, so cruel! I will scatter them in Yaaqob and disperse them throughout Israyl.
 - 8 Yahdah, your brothers will praise you;

your hand will be on the neck of your enemies; your father's sons will bow down to you.

- 9 You are a lion's cub, O Yahdah; you return from the prey, my son. Like a lion, he crouches and lies down; like the lion's breed, who dares to rouse him?
- 10 The scepter will not depart from Yahdah, nor a ruling staff; *Lawgiver*, from between his feet, until He comes to Whom tribute belongs, and the obedience of the nations is His.
- 11 Tethering his donkey to the vine; *tethering* his donkey colt to the choicest branch; he will wash his garments in wine; *he will wash* his robes in the blood of grapes.
- 12 His eyes will be darker than wine, and his teeth whiter than milk.
- 13 Zebulun will live by the seashore and become a haven for ships; his border will extend toward Sidon.
- 14 Issachar is a strong donkey lying down between two saddlebags.
- 15 When he sees how pleasing is his resting place, and how pleasant is his land, then he will bend his shoulder to bear a burden; and he will submit to forced labor.
- 16 Dan will provide his people with justice, as one of the tribes of Israyl.
- 17 Dan will be a serpent by the road; a viper along the path, that bites the horse's heels so its rider tumbles backward.
- 18 I have waited for Your salvation; *Yahshua Messiah*; O Yahweh!
- 19 Gad: A troop shall overcome him, but he will overcome at the last.
- 20 Asher's bread shall be rich, and he shall furnish delicacies for kings.
- 21 Naphtali is a doe set free, that utters beautiful words.
- 22 Yahseph is a wild colt, a wild colt by a spring; a wild donkey on a terraced hill.
- 23 With bitterness, archers attacked him; they shot at him with hostility.
- 24 But each one's bow would not bend, and their arms were weak, because of the hands of the Mighty One of Yaaqob; because of the Shepherd, the Rock of Israyl; because of your father's Father Who helps you; because of the Almighty Who blesses you:
- 25 With blessings of the heavens above; blessings of the deep that lies below; blessings of the breast and womb;
- 26 Blessings of grain stalk and blossom; blessings of mountains eternal; the delights of hills everlasting: Let all these rest on the head of Yahseph; on the crown of the head of the one set apart; *consecrated to a specific task*, from his brothers.
- 27 Benyamin is a ravenous wolf: In the morning he devours the foe, and in the evening he divides the plunder.
- 28 All these *are* the twelve tribes of Israyl, and this is what their father said to them when he bade them farewell, addressing to each an appropriate message.

We see in verse 1 that this Prophecy concerns the Last Days. The Prophets were inspired to finish the Prophecies about the family of Abraham that Yahweh is still dealing with—the Prophecies are still coming to pass. The lesson they will learn in the Last Days is a lesson they will never forget. This lesson or plan for the twelve tribes is already set and there is no turning it around. No one will live through the horrors that have started unless they repent and turn to Yahweh.

• Genesis 49:10-12—

- 10 The scepter will not depart from Yahdah, nor a ruling staff; *Lawgiver*, from between his feet, until He comes to Whom tribute belongs, and the obedience of the nations is His.
- 11 Tethering his donkey to the vine; *tethering* his donkey colt to the choicest branch; he will wash his garments in wine; *he will wash* his robes in the blood of grapes.
- 12 His eyes will be darker than wine, and his teeth whiter than milk.

This Prophecy shows both the Savior, Who died, was resurrected and ascended to the Right Hand of Yahweh, and the Last Days' House of Yahweh that the one prophesied Savior is now High Priest over. Yes, Yahweh's Last Days' Work is also prophesied in those verses. Call or write for details about this Prophecy.

The One to Whom the scepter was prophesied to be given came, but you rejected Him and nailed Him to a stake.

• Luke 24:25—

Then He said to them: O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken!

• Acts 3:13-26—

- 13 The Father of Abraham, Isaac, and Yaaqob, the Father of our fathers, glorified His Servant Yahshua, Whom you handed over and denied in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to release *Him*.
- 14 However, you denied the Holy One and the Just, and demanded that a murderer should be released to you;
- 15 And killed the Prince of Life, Whom Yahweh raised from the dead. Of this we are witnesses.
- 16 And His Name, through the faith in His Name, has made this man strong, whom you see and know. Yes, the faith which is through Him has given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all.
- 17 And now, brothers, I know that you did this through ignorance, as *did* also your rulers;
- 18 But those things which Yahweh foretold by the mouth of all the prophets, that Messiah must suffer, He has fulfilled this.
- 19 Repent therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out; that times of refreshing may come from the Presence of Yahweh;
- 20 And that He may send Yahshua, the Messiah Who was preached to you,
 - 21 Whom the heaven must retain until

the time of the restoration of all things, about which Yahweh spoke by the mouths of His Holy prophets since the world began.

- 22 For Mosheh truly said to the fathers: Yahweh your Father will raise up for you a Prophet like me, from your brothers. Him you will hear in all things, whatever He says to you.
- 23 And it will be that everyone who will not hear that Prophet will be utterly destroyed from among the people.
- 24 Yes, and all the prophets, from Samuyl to those who followed after, as many as have spoken, have foretold the same things about these days.
- 25 You are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which Yahweh made with our fathers, saying to Abraham: And in your Seed all the families of the earth will be blessed.
- 26 To you first, Yahweh having raised up His Son Yahshua, sent Him to <u>bless</u> you, in turning every one of you away from his iniquities.

This same Yahshua, Who would have turned Yahdah and Israyl from their iniquities, you rejected. You changed His Name in the Scriptures to that of Gods your fathers worshipped. In doing so, you shut yourselves off from Yahweh. Your fathers even changed their identity, now calling themselves Catholic (universal). They are still Babylon (confusion), the rebellious, religious system started by Cush. This condemned system still leads the kings of the earth today in rebellion against Righteousness; serving Yahweh only.

• Revelation 17:1-2—

- 1 And there came one of the seven malakim who had the seven bowls, and talked with me, saying to me: Come, I will show you the sentence of the great whore that sits upon many waters,
- 2 With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication; *practiced idolatry: God worship (the worship of elohim)*, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made <u>drunk with the wine of her fornication</u>.

Notice in verse 1, many waters. Revelation 17:15 shows that the waters are multitudes, nations, and tongues. Remember in Genesis 49:19 we saw that this family would become a multitude of nations.

In **Revelation 17:2** notice, the kings of the earth. **I Samuyl 8:1-8** shows that the kings of the east (elders), from which this family of the twelve tribes came, rejected Yahweh.

Yeremyah 23:15—

...profaneness has gone out into all the land.

We also see in Revelation 17:2, God worship.

• Yeremyah 23:26-27—

- 26 How long will *this* be in the heart of the prophets who prophesy lies? Yes, *they are* prophets of the deceit of their own minds;
- 27 Who devise; *plan and scheme*, to cause My People to forget My Name through their dreams, which they tell every man to his neighbor, just as their fathers have forgotten My Name for Baal; *Lord*.

■ Daniyl 7:25—

And he will speak *great* words against Yahweh...

Another thing we see in **Revelation** 17:2 is <u>drunk</u> which means Babylon or confusion. The schools of higher learning bring forth confusion by teaching against Yahweh's Laws.

• Romans 1:21-25-

- 21 Because that, when they knew Yahweh, they did not glorify *Him* as Father, nor were thankful, but became idolatrous; *God worshipers (worshipers of elohim)*, in their reasoning, and their senseless minds were darkened.
- 22 Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools; *simpletons*,
- 23 And exchanged the glory of the uncorruptible Father for images, made to resemble corruptible man, and birds, four-footed beasts, and creeping things.
- 24 Therefore, Yahweh also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own minds, to dishonor their own bodies between themselves:
- 25 Who exchanged the Truth of Yahweh for the lie; Lords (Baalim), Gods, Goddesses (Elohim) and demons, and worshiped and served the creation, rather than the Creator, Who is blessed forever. Praise Yahweh! Hallelu Yahweh!

● Revelation 17:3-6—

- 3 So he carried me away in the Spirit into the *midst of* God worshipers (worshipers of Elohim); and I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet colored beast, full of names of <u>blasphemy</u>, having <u>seven heads</u> and <u>ten horns</u>.
- 4 And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet color, and decked with gold, and precious stones, and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of <u>abominations</u> and <u>filthiness of her fornication</u>.
- 5 And upon her head was a name written: Mystery Babylon the great, the mother of the harlots and of the abominations of the earth.
- 6 And I saw the <u>woman drunk with the blood of the Saints</u>, and with the blood of the martyrs of Yahshua. And when I saw her, I wondered with great astonishment.

• Acts 7:52—

Which of the Prophets have not your fathers persecuted? And they have slain those who foretold the coming of the Just One; of Whom you now have become the betrayers and murderers.

• Revelation 17:7-9—

7 And the malak said to me: Why are

you astonished? I will tell you the <u>mystery</u> of the woman, and of the beast that carries her, which has the seven heads and ten horns.

8 The beast that you saw was, and is not, and will ascend out of the bottomless pit, and go into perdition. And those who dwell on the earth will wonder—whose names were not written in The Book of Life from the foundation of the world—when they see the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.

9 And here is the mind which has wisdom: The <u>seven heads are seven mountains</u> on which the woman sits.

The Basic Everyday Encyclopedia, page 451, gives us the following information concerning these seven mountains (hills).

Rome (the "Eternal City"), ... Traditionally founded 753 BC by Romulus and Remus, <u>built</u> on 7 hills...

• Compton's Pictured Encyclopedia, 1948, Volume 12, page 144, also tells us about the city of seven hills.

...the "<u>City of Seven Hills.</u>" ...the Capitoline, Palatine, Aventine, Quirinal, Viminal, Esquiline, and Caelian hills. ...the <u>seat of the papacy</u>, the head of the great Roman Catholic Church.

• Revelation 17:10-18—

- 10 And there are seven kings: Five have fallen, and one is, *and* the other has not yet come; and when he comes, he must continue a short time.
- 11 And the beast that was, and is not, indeed he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and is going into perdition.
- 12 And the ten horns which you saw are ten kings, which as yet have not received a kingdom; but receive authority as kings one hour with the beast.
- 13 These have one purpose and they give their power and authority to the beast.
- 14 These will make war with the Lamb, but the Lamb will overcome them; for He is the Ruler of rulers and King of kings; and those who are with Him *are* called, and Chosen, and Faithful.
- 15 And he said to me: The waters which you saw, where the whore sits, are peoples, and multitudes, and nations, and languages.
- 16 And the ten horns which you saw upon the beast, these will hate the whore, and will make her desolate and naked, and will eat her flesh, and burn her with fire.
- 17 But the Gods have put in their hearts to perform their will; and to agree, and give their kingdom to the beast, until the Words; *Prophecies*, of Yahweh will be fulfilled.
- 18 And the <u>woman whom you saw</u>, is that <u>great city</u> which <u>reigns over the kings</u> of the earth.

This is the same great city that sits on seven hills (**Revelation 17:9**).

• Revelation 18:1-5—

1 And after these things I saw another Malak come down from heaven, having great authority; and the earth was enlightened with His Glory.

2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying: <u>Babylon the great is fallen</u>, <u>is fallen</u>, and is become the habitation of demons, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.

- 3 For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth have grown rich through the abundance of her delicacies.
- 4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying: Come out of her, My People, so that you do not partake in her sins, and so that you do not receive of her plagues,
- 5 For her <u>sins have reached unto</u> <u>heaven</u>, and Yahweh has remembered her iniquities!

Remember, sin is the breaking of Yahweh's Laws.

● I Yahchanan 3:4—

Whoever commits sin, transgresses also the Laws; for sin is the transgression of the Laws.

You had better start thinking about leaving Rome.

• Revelation 18:5-9—

- 5 For her sins have reached unto heaven, and Yahweh has remembered her iniquities!
- 6 Render to her just as she rendered to you, and repay her double according to her works! In the cup which she has mixed, mix for her double!
- 7 In the measure that she glorified herself, and lived luxuriously, so in that measure give her torment and sorrow! For she says in her heart: I sit a queen, and am no widow, and will see no sorrow.
- 8 Therefore, her plagues will come in one day—death, and mourning, and famine; and she will be utterly burned with fire; for Just *is* Father Yahweh Who judges her.
- 9 And the <u>kings of the earth</u>, who have committed fornication and lived luxuriously with her, will wail over her, and lament for her, <u>when they will see the smoke</u> of her burning.

This is a nuclear burning and should be taken very seriously. You have many enemies among your brothers, the rest of the family of Abraham, and they are acquiring nuclear weapons, which are spoken of here. You have followed the way of Cain, which is continual war.

The Prophecies are rapidly coming to pass. The Prophecy concerning the burning of the city that sits on seven hills will soon be fulfilled. We are now in this time period.

You are responsible for the nuclear proliferation taking place. Where will

you Pharisees hide from the wrath that you created?

• Yeremyah 23:24—

Can anyone hide himself in secret places so I cannot see him? says Yahweh. Do I not fill heaven and earth? says Yahweh.

• Acts 7:51-53-

51 You stiffnecked; stubborn, and uncircumcised in heart and ears! You do always resist Spirit Holy! <u>Just as your fathers did</u>, so you do also!

52 Which of the Prophets have not your fathers persecuted? And they have slain those who foretold the coming of the Just One; of Whom you now have become the betrayers and murderers—

53 You, who have received the Laws as it was ordained *and* delivered by malakim, have not kept *it!*

Let's look again at:

• II Kings 23:27—

So Yahweh had said: I will also remove Yahdah from My sight, just as I have removed Israyl, and I will cast off this city Yerusalem which I have chosen, and the House, about which I said: My Name shall be there.

Notice the last part of this Prophecy. "I will cast off this city Yerusalem which I have chosen, and the House, about which I said: My Name shall be there." Remember Yahweh's Plan and Law for Salvation in this.

• Deuteronomy 12:5, 7-8—

- 5 But you are to seek the habitation of your Father; The House of Yahweh—the place which Yahweh your Father shall choose out of all your tribes to establish His Name—and there you must go.
- 7 There, in front of Yahweh your Father, you and your families shall eat, and you shall rejoice in all that you have put your hand to do, because Yahweh your Father has blessed you.
- 8 You must not at all do as we are doing here this day—every man doing whatever is right in his own eyes.

The Great Prophet Micahyah was inspired to write concerning moving The House of Yahweh for the Last Days. Remember **Genesis 49** shows the Last Days.

• Genesis 49:1, 10-12—

- 1 Then Yaaqob called for his sons, and said; Gather together, so I may tell you what will befall you in the last days.
- 10 The scepter will not depart from Yahdah, nor a ruling staff; *Lawgiver*, from between his feet, until He comes to Whom tribute belongs, and the obedience of the nations is His.
- 11 Tethering his donkey to the vine; *tethering* his donkey colt to the choicest branch; he will wash his garments in wine; *he will wash* his robes in the blood of grapes.
- 12 His eyes will be darker than wine, and his teeth whiter than milk.

We are in the Last Days; so where is The House of Yahweh?

Micahvah 4:1-3-

1 But in the Last Days it will come to pass that the mountain; promotion, of The House of Yahweh will be established in the chief of the nations. It will be raised above all congregations; and all peoples will eventually flow to it.

2 And many people will go and say; Come, and let us go up to Abel; to the mountain; to promote/praise Yahweh, to the House of the Father of Yaaqob, and He will teach us of His Ways, and we will walk in His Paths. For the Laws and the Words of Yahweh will be restored to Abel by those who keep all His Laws and who *are taught* by the Priest who teaches peace.

3 And He will judge between many people, and rebuke strong nations afar off; and they will beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks. Nation will not lift up a sword against nation, nor will they learn war anymore.

Revelation 16:12—

And the sixth malak poured out his bowl upon the great river Euphrates; and its water was dried up, so that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.

Don't miss the next exciting article about the way of the kings of the east. It's not all bad. In fact, the greatest part of all is yet to come. What Yahweh has allowed thus far is for the benefit of mankind. Man desires to rule himself. He desires to be guided by the fulfillment of his own lusts, but that doesn't grant one peaceful living.

The Prophesied Savior set an Example for us of the true concept of the Laws of Yahweh and the love they teach. He was a Perfect Servant of Yahweh to mankind.

The prophesied House of Yahweh in these Last Days has the guidance of the Savior Yahshua Messiah Who sits as the Prophesied Judge and High Priest over Yahweh's Last Days' Work. This is shown in a book that was written especially to the Hebrews, the family of Abraham. This is Yahweh's call to the twelve tribes in these Last Days. Notice:

• Hebrews 1:1-4—

1 Yahweh, Who at various times and in different ways spoke in times past to our fathers through the Prophets,

2 Has in these last days spoken to us through His Son, Whom He has appointed heir of all things, for Whom He also made the world;

3 Who, being the reflection of the Perfection of Yahweh, and the representation of Yahweh's Plan, by upholding all things concerning that which was spoken by Yahweh through the Law and the Prophets, when He had purged sins, sat down on the right hand of Yahweh on high,

4 Becoming so much better than the malakim, He has by inheritance obtained a more excellent Name than they.

Hebrews 10:11-18-

11 And every priest stands daily, ministering and offering again and again the same sacrifices, which can never take

12 But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at

the right hand of Yahweh,

13 From that time on, waiting until His enemies are made His footstool.

14 For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are sanctified;

15 And the Spirit Holy also testifies to us: for after He had first said:

16 This is the Covenant that I will renew with them after those days, says Yahweh: I will put My Laws into their hearts, and in their minds I will write them;

17 Then He says: Their sins and iniquities I will remember no more.

18 Now where there is remission of these, there is no longer an offering for

This fulfilled Prophecy is yours to partake of if you:

1. Believe the inspired Prophets.

Luke 24:25, 27-

25 Then He said to them: O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the Prophets have spoken!

27 And beginning at Mosheh; the Laws, and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.

• Yahchanan 5:22, 24-47—

22 For the Father does not judge any man, but has committed all judgment to

24 Truly, truly, I say to you: He who hears My Words; My Teachings pertaining to the Laws and the Prophets, believing Yahweh Who sent Me, has everlasting life, and will not come under condemnation; but has passed from death to life.

25 Truly, truly, I say to you: The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of Yahweh; and those who hear will live.

26 For just as the Father has life in Himself, so He has given to the Son to have life in Himself;

27 And has given Him authority to execute judgment also, because He is the Son of Man.

28 Do not be astonished at this-for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His Voice.

29 And will come forth. Those who have practiced Righteousness will be resurrected in order to live; and those who have practiced wickedness will be resurrected in order to be damned.

30 I can of My own self do nothing; as I hear, I judge. And My Judgment is just; because I do not seek My own will, but the will of the Father Who has sent Me.

31 If I alone testify in My behalf, My testimony is not valid.

32 There is Another Who testifies in My behalf, and I know that the testimony which He witnesses about Me is true.

33 You sent to Yahchanan, and he testified to the truth.

34 However, I do not accept testimony from man; but I say these things, so that you might be saved.

35 For he was a burning and a shining lamp, and you were willing for a time to

rejoice in his light.

36 But I have testimony *even* greater than *that* of Yahchanan: the works which the Father has given Me to finish—the same works that I do-they testify on My behalf that the Father has sent Me;

37 And the Father Himself, Who has sent Me, testifies on My behalf. You have neither heard His voice at any time, nor

seen His shape;

38 Nor do you have His Word dwelling in you; you reject the Laws and the Prophets, because Whom He has sent, Him you do not believe.

39 Search the Scriptures; for in them you think you have eternal life—and these are they which testify of Me.

40 But you will not come to Me, that

you might have life. 41 I do not receive honor from men.

42 But I know you, that you do not have

the love of Yahweh in you.

- 43 I have come in My Father's Name, but you do not follow Me. Let another come in his own name; him you will follow in order to obey!
- 44 How can you believe, when you accept honor from one another, but do not seek the honor that *comes* from Yahweh
- 45 Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father. There is one who accuses you—Mosheh, in whom you trust!
- 46 For had you believed Mosheh, you would have believed Me, for he wrote about Me.
- 47 But if you do not believe his writings, how will you believe My Words? How will you believe the Laws and the Prophets?

Yahchanan 5:39, 46, 37—

39 Search the Scriptures; for in them you think you have eternal life-and these are they which testify of Me

46 For had you believed Mosheh, you would have believed Me, for he wrote about

37 And the Father Himself, Who has sent Me, testifies on My behalf. You have neither heard His voice at any time, nor seen His shape.

Yahchanan 6:29, 45-47—

29 Yahshua answered, and said to them: This is the Work of Yahweh: that you believe in Him Whom He has sent.

45 It is written in the Prophets: And they all will be taught by Yahweh. Therefore, everyone who has heard the Father, and has learned from Him, comes

46 For no one knows the Father, except He who is begotten of Yahweh—He knows the Father.

47 Truly, truly, I say to you: He who believes has everlasting life.

Yahchanan 5:22, 28-29—

22 For the Father does not judge any man, but has committed all judgment to the Son:

28 Do not be astonished at this—<u>for</u> the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will <u>hear His Voice</u>,

29 And will come forth. Those who have practiced Righteousness will be resurrected *in order* to live; and those who have practiced wickedness will be resurrected *in order* to be damned.

● I Yahchanan 3:7-8—

7 Little children, let no man deceive you; he who practices Righteousness is Righteous, just as He is Righteous.

8 He who commits sin is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of Yahweh was manifested; that He might destroy the works of the devil.

• Hebrews 10:25-26-

25 Not forsaking the gathering of ourselves together, as the manner of some *is*, but exhorting *one another*; and so much the more as you see the day approaching.

26 For if we sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the Truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins.

2. Repent and be converted.

Yechetzqyah 18:20-24—

20 The soul that sins, it will die. The son will not bear the iniquity of the father, nor will the father bear the iniquity of the son. The Righteousness of the Righteous will be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked will be upon himself.

21 But if the wicked will turn from all his sins that he has committed, and keep all My Statutes, and do that which is Lawful and right, *then* he will surely live; he will not die.

22 And his transgressions that he has committed will not be mentioned against him; in his Righteousness that he has done, he will live.

23 Do I have any pleasure at all that the wicked should die? says Father Yahweh: No, *but rather* that he would turn back from his *wicked* ways, and live.

24 But when the Righteous turns away from his Righteousness and commits iniquity, and does according to all the abominations that the wicked *man* does—should he live? All his Righteousness that he has done will not be mentioned *in his behalf*. In his trespass that he has trespassed, and in his sin that he has sinned, in them he will die.

• Acts 3:13-15, 17-20—

13 The Father of Abraham, Isaac, and Yaaqob, the Father of our fathers, glorified His Servant Yahshua, Whom you handed over and denied in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to release *Him*.

14 However, you denied the Holy One and the Just, and demanded that a murderer should be released to you;

15 And killed the Prince of Life, Whom Yahweh raised from the dead. Of this we are witnesses.

17 And now, brothers, I know that you did this through ignorance, as *did* also your rulers:

18 But those things which Yahweh foretold by the mouth of all the Prophets, that Messiah must suffer, He has fulfilled this.

19 Repent therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out; that times of refreshing may come from the Presence of Yahweh:

20 And that He may send Yahshua, the Messiah Who was preached to you,

● II Kepha 2:21-22—

21 For it would have been better for them not to have known the way of Righteousness, than, after they have known *it*, to turn from the Holy Laws delivered to them.

22 There has befallen them the thing spoken of in the true proverb: A dog returns to his own vomit, and: A sow is washed, only to wallow again in the mire.

Many of our forefathers persecuted and killed the Prophets and the Savior. But as the Prophet Yechetzqyah shows, the children do not lose their inheritance because of the sins of their fathers, unless they follow the ways of their sinful fathers.

All judgment of mankind has been given to the Prophesied Savior.

• Yahchanan 5:22, 28-29—

22 For the Father does not judge any man, but has committed all judgment to the Son;

28 Do not be astonished at this—for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His Voice,

29 And will come forth. Those who have practiced Righteousness will be resurrected *in order* to live; and those who have practiced wickedness will be resurrected *in order* to be damned.

• Revelation 20:11-15—

11 And I saw a great white Throne, and Him Who sat on it, from Whose face the powers of the earth and the powers of the heavens, the Gods (elohim), were driven away; for the verdict was reached that there is no place for them.

12 And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before Yahweh. And the books were opened; and another book was opened, which is *The Book* of Life. And the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and sheol; *the grave*, delivered up the dead which were in them. And they were judged, every man, according to his works.

14 And death and sheol were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

15 And whoever was not found written in The Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.

Revelation 22:12-14—

12 And behold, I come quickly, and My Reward is with Me, to give every man

according as his work will be.

13 I am the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End.

14 Blessed *are* those who keep His Laws, that they may have right to the Tree of Life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

Remember and believe the words of the Prophets.

• Luke 24:25—

Then He said to them: O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the Prophets have spoken!

Micahyah 4:1-3—

1 But in the Last Days it will come to pass *that* the mountain; *promotion*, of The House of Yahweh will be established in the chief of the nations. It will be raised above all congregations; and all peoples will *eventually* flow to it.

2 And many people will go and say; Come, and let us go up to Abel; to the mountain; to promote/praise Yahweh, to the House of the Father of Yaaqob, and He will teach us of His Ways, and we will walk in His Paths. For the Laws and the Words of Yahweh will be restored to Abel by those who keep all His Laws and who are taught by the Priest who teaches peace.

As prophesied, the scepter or authority has been given to the Son of Man.

• Genesis 1:26—

Then Yahweh said: I will make man in My Image, according to My Likeness; they will have rulership over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, over the cattle, and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth.

• Genesis 49:10-12—

10 The scepter will not depart from Yahdah, nor a ruling staff; *Lawgiver*, from between his feet, until He comes to Whom tribute belongs, and the obedience of the nations is His.

11 Tethering his donkey to the vine; *tethering* his donkey colt to the choicest branch; he will wash his garments in wine; *he will wash* his robes in the blood of grapes.

12 His eyes will be darker than wine, and his teeth whiter than milk.

The Chosen Branch is at work now in the Last Days' Established House. Yahweh says to all who will hear His House:

• Revelation 22:17—

And the Spirit and the brides, say: Come! And let him who hears, say: Come! And let him who is thirsty come. And whoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

These Prophecies, written by the Prophets of old, are now being fulfilled before your very eyes. This is the last calling before the coming of Yahshua Messiah.

• **Revelation 7:1-10**—

- 1 And after these things I saw four messengers standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, so that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.
- 2 And I saw another Malak ascending from the east, having the Seal of the living Father; and he cried with a loud voice to the four messengers, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea,
- 3 Saying: Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, until we have sealed the servants of our Father in their foreheads.
- 4 And I heard the number of those who were sealed: *And there were* sealed 144,000 of all the tribes of the children of Israyl.
- 5 Of the tribe of Yahdah *were* sealed 12,000. Of the tribe of Reuben *were* sealed 12,000. Of the tribe of Gad *were* sealed 12,000.
- 6 Of the tribe of Asher *were* sealed 12,000. Of the tribe of Naphtali *were* sealed 12,000. Of the tribe of Menasheh *were* sealed 12,000.
- 7 Of the tribe of Simeon *were* sealed 12,000. Of the tribe of Levi *were* sealed 12,000. Of the tribe of Issachar *were* sealed 12,000.
- 8 Of the tribe of Zebulun *were* sealed 12,000. Of the tribe of Yahseph *were* sealed 12,000. Of the tribe of Benyamin *were* sealed 12,000.
- 9 After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the Throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and with palm branches; *taught to keep Yahweh*'s *Feasts*, in their hands;
- 10 And crying with a loud voice, saying: Salvation to our Father Who sits upon the Throne, and unto the Lamb!

Anyone and everyone who will repent of sin and convert to practicing Yahweh's Laws can be in this calling and become a part of Yahweh's Last Days' Prophesied Work.
